The abstract should summarize the content of the paper. Try to keep the abstract below 150 words. Do not have references or displayed equations in the abstract. Paper form is a necessary condition for its publication, as well as its content.

1. Introduction

The text must be in English. The submitted typeset scripts of each contribution must be in their final form and of good appearance because they will be printed directly. This document is set in 10-point Times New Roman.

2. Headings and Footnotes

1. Major headings are to be column centered in a bold font without underline. They should be numbered. 2. 'Headings and Footnotes' at the top of the paragraph is the main heading with the <u>font size 12 of Times New Roman</u>.

2.1 Subheadings

Subheadings should be same as the above headings "2.1 Subheadings" with font size 11. They should start at the left-hand margin on a separate line.

The top of this paragraph illustrates a subheading.

Title: The title should be centered a cross the top of the first page and should have a distinctive <u>font of 18 points Century</u>. It should be in bold font and in lower case with initial capitals.

Author' Name and Address: The authors' names and addresses should be centered below the title. These lines should be 9 points Times New Roman.

Keywords: From4to6keywordsshouldfollowthe abstract as a subheading: *Key words*, of the Abstract.

Illustrations or pictures: Allhalftoneillustrationsor pictures should be clear black and white prints. Supply the best quality/high resolution illustrations or pictures possible.

2.1 Footnotes

Footnotes should be typed in single-line spacing at the bottom of the page and column where it is cited. Footnotes should be rare.

3.1 Tables and Figures

To insert "Tables" or "Figures", please paste the data as stated below. All tables and figures must be given sequential numbers (1, 2, 3, etc.) and have a caption placed below the figure ("FigCaption") or above the table("Fig Table") being described, using 8pt font and please make use of the specified style "caption" from the drop-down menu of style categories
