

The Committee was apprised that to resolve the issues of charging of funds/fee in Professional and Non-Professional Courses, this Committee was constituted by the Vice-Chancellor. This Committee met on 03.12.2021, 14.01.2022 and finally on 14.02.2022. The minutes of the Committee were placed before the authorities for consideration and orders. The authorities have referred back the matter to the Committee in view of the Executive Council decision made in its meeting held on 06.05.2022 with regard to reducing of various fees as the minutes of this Committee dated 14.02.2022 has reference of the earlier Executive Council Resolution i.e. Resolution No. 29 dated 31.12.2021 and not the latest one.

The Committee again deliberated upon the issue at length and recommends as under:-

The Committee resolved that the decision taken in the Committee meeting held on 14.02.2022 may go as it is as the Committee has not reduced/increased the existing fees/funds rather only grouping of existing fees of different programs for the Colleges has been proposed so that the issue of charging of fees/funds in Professional and Non-Professional Courses may be resolved.

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MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE HELD ON 03.12.2021 AND 14.01.2022 AND 14.02.2022 IN THE COMMITTEE ROOM, ADJACENT TO THE REGISTRAR OFFICE, M.D.UNIVERSITY, ROHTAK TO RESOLVE THE ISSUE OF CHARGING OF FEE IN PROFESSIONAL AND NON-PROFESSIONAL COURSES BEING RUN BY THE UNIVERSITY THROUGH ITS DEPARTMENTS/COLLEGES.

Following were present:

1. Dean Academic Affairs - Convener
2. Dean, Faculty of Engineering and Technology
3. Dean, Faculty of Law
4. Dean, Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences
5. Dean, Faculty of Inter-disciplinary studies
6. Finance Officer -Special Invitee

First meeting of the Committee was held on 03.12.2021 in which the Accounts Branch was directed to prepare a list of all fees/funds charged by the University from the students of the Departments and affiliated Colleges/Institutes so that it may be checked whether the funds are same or different in the Departments/Institutes and affiliated Colleges.

The Accounts Branch presented the list of Programs offered by the affiliated Colleges/Institutes on the basis of which the Accounts Branch has charged the fee and funds from the Colleges/Institutes. The Committee also perused the Chapter-VI of the Admission Brochure for the session 2021-22 applicable to the affiliated Colleges/Institutes and found disparity in the fees/funds charged from the students of the affiliated Colleges due to non-categorisation of the Programs by the University.

In view of the above, the Committee deliberated on the issue at length and **recommends as under:-**

1. That all the fees and fees/funds already charged from the affiliated Colleges/Institutes by the Accounts Branch till the session 2021-22 be regularised by the University to avoid any litigation for consideration of request for refund of fees/funds to the affiliated Colleges/Institutes.
2. The Committee also noted the decision of the Executive Council made vide Resolution No. 29 of its meeting held on 31.12.2021 vide which, the issue of charging of fee/funds relating to Registration Return and Continuation Return stands automatically resolved. In view of the above said resolution, further necessary action may be taken by the concerned offices accordingly in this regard.
3. So far as matter relating to charging of Development Fee and Youth Welfare Fee from the affiliated Colleges/Institute as mentioned in the Chapter-VI in the Admission

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Brochure is concerned, the Committee recommends that uniformity in fees/funds needs to be maintained by the University by taking into consideration of the courses being offered under the purview of the AICTE, NCTE, PCI and BCI etc. , and the same may be considered in the Fee Structure Committee to make it applicable from the session 2022-23 onwards with the proposal as under keeping in light of the Executive Council's Resolution No. 29 dated 31.12.2021:

Further, the Committee recommends that the fee may be increased atleast 10% to 15% every year in each Program being run by the UTDs and MDU-CPAS, Gurugram and affiliated Colleges/Institutes under the head of 'Development Fee/Fund' to meet out the expenditure of the University as these fees has not been revised from last many years. Therefore, the above proposal may be referred to the Revenue Generation Committee for consideration.
