Proceedings of meetings of the Sub Committee, constituted by the Vice-Chancellor regarding conduct of Terminal Semester/ Year examinations of UG/PG and other Programmes, held on 26.08.2020 & 27.08.2020 at 10 a.m. in the wake of situation arising out of COVID-19 in the Committee Room adjacent to the office of the Registrar, M.D. University, Rohtak:

The Committee deliberated on the issue of conduct of examinations through Online/Offline Mode and after analysing the data pertaining to examinations, made the following recommendations:-

- Additional Instructions to the students opting for Online Exam mode in the ongoing survey:
  - Students will ensure availability of a working Camera on their Laptops/Desktops/ Android Mobile Phones.
  - 2. They will be required to show their ID proofs on Camera.
  - 3. Students will be under Camera Surveillance of Invigilators during examinations.
  - If any student is found involved in any malpractice(s) during Camera Surveillance, then the examination of the student would be cancelled.
  - One MCQ will be on display on the screen at a time. However, a student shall be allowed to skip forward and move back to questions.
- 2. Instructions regarding conduct of Terminal Semester/Year Theory (Descriptive/MCQ) & Practical Examinations:-
  - The Practical Examinations for all UG/PG/other programmes will be conducted from 01.09.2020 to 10.09.2020 in online/offline mode. For this purpose, arrangements shall be made by the concerned HODs/Principals/Directors at their own level. The marks shall be awarded in equal proportions on the basis of one Presentation related to the Practical, Record File and Viva-voce.
  - 2. The theory papers of terminal exams of all Courses will be held as under:-
  - A). The theory exams of UG programs i.e. B.A, B.Sc, B.Com 6<sup>th</sup> Semester (Pass Course), B.A, B.Com 3<sup>rd</sup> year of DDE (Annual) and B.Ed 2<sup>nd</sup> Year, in which the number of students is large, will be conducted through offline as well as online mode based on MCQ Question paper.
  - a) The Architecture of Scheme of Examination will be as follows:
    - The two/three Papers of the same subject will be merged into one paper with separate parts/sections corresponding to each paper. Examples are two papers of Physics, three papers of Chemistry, three papers of Maths in B.Sc. Non-Medical stream.
    - ii. Each Question Paper after merging two papers will comprise 100 MCQs. The two parts/sections representing two papers will contain 50 questions of each paper. A

- candidate will have the choice to attempt any 40 questions out of 50 in each part/section. Each part/section corresponding to a paper will bear a maximum score of 40. The exam will be of 90 minutes.
- iii. Likewise, the three papers of the same subject will be merged into one paper with three parts/sections containing 150 MCQs (50 of each paper). A candidate will have the choice to attempt 40 questions in each part/section, corresponding to the maximum score accorded to each paper. The exam will be of 135 minutes.
- iv. In case any program consists of odd number of papers e.g. 5 or 7 or 9, the last paper would be single. The exam will be of 45 minutes.
- v. There shall be no provision for re-evaluation in MCQ based question paper.
- vi. There will be no Negative marking in Offline as well as in Online mode.
- vii. The question-booklets and answer-keys shall be uploaded on the University website for inviting queries/ grievance, if any.
- b) Paper in the subjects of English and Hindi of UG programs in the offline mode will be conducted in the odd-even sequence of Roll Numbers separately as some of the colleges have very large number of students in these compulsory papers. For online mode of examination, there will be a single paper.
- c) Wherever applicable, question papers shall be set up in bi-lingual form i.e. where medium of instructions are as English and Hindi.
- d) Two sets of Question Papers (MCQ) for each subject shall be got set by the Controller of Examinations.
- B). The theory exams all other remaining programs will be conducted through offline as well as online in descriptive/subjective mode.
  - 3. The examinations of M.Phil/Ph.D. courses shall commence w.e.f: 07.09.2020 through offline as well as online in descriptive/subjective mode and of remaining programs from 11.09.2020.
  - 4. Instructions to be followed in offline as well as online descriptive mode of examinations: -
    - In case of Online mode, all the HODs/Principals/Directors shall ensure to supply
      question papers to the concerned students through electronic mode in prescribed
      time. For this purpose the following sub-committee will recommend the operational

- iv). In morning session, the time of examination for online mode will be for 2 (Two) hours i.e. 10.00 A.M. to 12 noon including uploading the visible image (JPG/ PDF format) of written pages. In case of offline mode, the time of examination will be 1 hour 45 minutes i.e. 10.00 A.M. to 11.45 A.M.
- v) In evening session, the time of examination for online mode will be for 2 (Two) hours i.e. 02.00 P.M. to 04:00 P.M including uploading the visible image (JPG/PDF format) of written pages. In case of offline mode, the time of examination will be 1 hour 45 minutes i.e. 02:00 P.M. to 03.45 P.M.

vi) The awards after the evaluation will be submitted by the concerned HODs/Principals/Directors to the University within seven days from the date of examinations of the paper.
