MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF CBCS BOARD HELD ON 12.03.2020 AT 10:00 AM IN THE COMMITTEE ROOM ADJACENT TO THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE, M. D. UNIVERSITY, ROHTAK TO CONSIDER THE VARIOUS ISSUES WITH REGARD TO OPEN ELECTIVE COURSES FROM THE SESSION 2019-20 & 2020-21 UNDER CBCS IN VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS.

The following decisions were taken:

- 1. The minutes of previous meeting of the CBCS Board held on 27.09.2018 be confirmed.
- 2. To consider the recommendations of HOD (Statistics) dated 06.02.2020 that the following two Open Elective papers may be included in the list of Open Elective courses for P.G courses under CBCS w.e.f the session 2019-20:-
 - (i) Statistical Programming Using R Language (2nd semester).
 - (ii) Official Statistics (3rd semester) from the session 2020-21.

The Committee resolved that the course 'Statistical Programming Using R Language' for 2nd semester be approved to be included in the list of Open Elective courses w.e.f 2019-20. However, it be a one time exception for the students of the Department of Statistics for opting this paper as open elective. Further, the course 'Official Statistics' (3rd Semester) from the session 2020-21 be approved.

- 3. To consider the recommendations of PGBOS in History and Arch. made vide Reso. no. 2 that the following four new papers of Open Elective Subjects under CBCS may be introduced w.e.f session 2020-21:
 - (i) Nationalism in India
 - (ii) Constitutional and Administrative History of India (1858-1950) for 2nd sem.
 - (ii) Survey of Sources of Indian History
 - (iv) Cultural Heritage of Haryana in 3rd sem.

The Committee resolved that the course 'Constitutional and Administrative History of India (1858-1950)' for 2ndsem. and the course 'Cultural Heritage of Haryana' in 3rd semester be approved from the session 2020-21.



4. To consider the recommendations of PGBOS in Mathematics made vide Reso. no. 2 of its meeting held on 01.10.2019 that paper of Vedic Mathematics be introduced in even semesters in PG courses under CBCS as an Open Elective course w.e.f the session 2019-2020.

The Committee resolved that the course 'Vedic Mathematics' in even semesters in PG courses under CBCS as an Open Elective course w.e.f the session 2020-2021 be approved.

- 5. To consider the recommendations of PGBOS in Mathematics made vide Reso. no. 3 of its meeting held on 01.10.2019 that following Non-Technology PG MOOCs Courses may be introduced in even semester in the pool of Open Elective Courses being run in the University w.e.f the session 2019-20:
 - Academic Writing (i)
 - **Animations** (ii)
 - Applied Multivariate Analysis (iii)
 - Biostatistics and Mathematical Biology (iv)
 - Mathematical Economics (v)
 - Research Ethics (vi)
 - Veda and Srimad Bhagvad Gita (vii)

The Committee resolved that the above PG MOOCs courses be approved from the session 2020-21. Further, resolved that other Departments may also identify more number of Open Elective Courses in the MOOC's outlay. The University may have a basket of Open Elective Courses in MOOC's outlay. Further resolved that the guidelines regarding Open

Elective/Foundation courses may be revisited by a Committee.
