GUIDELINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT AND FULL PAPER

The abstract should be around 300 words. It should cover title, background, methodology, findings/results and 3 to 4 key words. Full paper should be in standard format (Font: Times New Roman, 12 font size, 1.5 line spacing) and normally be about 3000-4000 words in length. Author(s) name (s) and affiliation should be shown on the separate sheet along with the title of the paper. Participants are required to register by clicking the link. Abstract should include names of Author/Co-authors, with affiliation. Email and mobile number also be given in the abstract. Maximum of three authors (One principal author and two co-authors) are allowed per paper.

STEPS FOR REGISTRATION

STEP I

At the outset, the participants will prepare an abstract and pay the registration fee in advance at SB Collect. Before making registration on Google Form, please keep the fee receipt (PDF format) downloaded from SB Collect and an Abstract (MS word format) ready.

STEP II

Registration will be accepted only through Google form. Each of participants (author as well as co-authors has to register paying the applicable processing –cum- registration fee separately. Please **do not send** the abstract and fee receipt by Email/Whatsapp etc. otherwise paper may be rejected. Just use google form for uploading abstract and fee receipt The link for submitting full paper will be shared at later stage.


