1. Inspirational Quotes in the Library

2. Green Initiative – Campus Plantation Drive

3. Effective Smart Board Utilization

All faculty members are encouraged to integrate smart boards actively into classroom teaching, making lessons more interactive, visual, and technology-driven, thereby enriching student engagement.

4. Lighting in Girls' Common Room

Immediate action will be taken to improve lighting facilities in the Girls' Common Room to ensure a safe, well-lit, and comfortable environment for students.

5. Arrangement of Finance/Accounting Software

The Centre will initiate a formal request to the university to procure finance/accounting software to aid academic learning and office operations, especially for commerce and management disciplines.

6. Activity Calendar Preparation

An Activity Calendar outlining academic and co-curricular events will be prepared and displayed at the beginning of each semester, enabling better planning and student participation.

7. Committee and Cell Activities


Each functional committee and student cell will be required to organize at least two activities per semester, ensuring continuous engagement and holistic development.

8. Curtain and Fabric Maintenance

A regular dry-cleaning schedule for curtains and other fabric furnishings will be established to maintain cleanliness and hygiene across the campus.

9. Display of Mandatory Disclosures

Important information such as Anti-Ragging Policies, Discipline Committee details, and other statutory notices will be clearly displayed on designated boards for student awareness and compliance.



10. Establishment of Boys' NCC Unit

A proposal to establish an NCC unit for boys will be pursued on priority, promoting discipline, leadership, and national service among male students.

11. Fire Safety and Extinguisher Maintenance

All fire extinguishers across the campus will be inspected and refilled periodically to ensure campus safety and emergency preparedness.

12. Functional Computer Lab with Wi-Fi Access

Computer labs will be made fully operational with stable Wi-Fi connectivity, providing seamless access to digital learning resources for students and faculty.

13. Organization of Expert Talks and Seminars

Departments will schedule regular expert lectures, workshops, and seminars to provide students with industry exposure and academic enrichment beyond textbooks.

14. Girls' Washroom Maintenance and Upgradation

Infrastructure in the girls' washroom will be upgraded, including repair of doors and sanitation facilities, ensuring hygiene, safety, and dignity.


15. Periodic Overhead Tank Cleaning

A schedule for regular cleaning of overhead water tanks will be implemented to maintain water quality and campus hygiene.


16. Daily Display of Faculty on Leave
