UGC regulations/ guidelines for Access, Quality and Inclusion.

Kindly refer to the subject cited above.

I have been directed to share the following guidelines/regulations for strict compliance:-

- Accessibility Guidelines and Standards for Higher Education Institutions and Universities was (i) released in June 2022 to suggest the institutes to make provisions for persons with disabilities and to provide them an accessible environment for their barrier-free participation in all respects. It also aims to assist institutes in developing an effective accessible mechanism at their premises for the persons with disabilities ranging from the admission process till the completion of the course.
- Basic facilities and amenities for a safe, secure environment for Women and Women Cell for sensitization, policy implementation, monitoring, and grievance redressal in HEIs was released on 22.12.2022 to provide guidelines and solutions to the most pressing issues for women in educational institutes: infrastructural facilities and amenities for a safe and secure environment, and the establishment of women cells to act as centers for gender sensitization, policy formulation and implementation and grievance redressal.
- (iii) Minimum Standards and procedures for award of Ph.D. degree Regulations, 2022 which inter alia, provides that female Ph.D. scholars and Persons with Disabilities (having more than 40% disability) may be allowed an additional relaxation of two (2) years. Female Ph.D. Scholars may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave for up to 240 days in the entire duration of the Ph.D. programme.
- Guidelines for Promotion of Physical Fitness, Sports, Students' Health, Welfare, Psychological and Emotional Well-Being at IIEIs of India was released on 12.04.2023 to set encourage an attitude of physical fitness and to set up Student Services Centres (SSC) in institutes to deal and manage the problems related to stress and emotional adjustment of students, especially from rural backgrounds, female students, students from divergent cultural backgrounds, and students with special needs".
