44(17) Consideration of the recommendations of the Examinations Reform Committee made in its meeting held on 15.01.2026 (Annexure A/121 pages 561-562, already circulated) which is in pursuant to the decision of the Executive Council taken vide Reso. No. 10(41) dated 29.09.2025 regarding consideration of minimum percentage for mass scale failure which is already at least 90% in present rule (Executive Council Reso. No. 98 dated 22.12.2014). The Examinations Reform Committee revisited the same and the recommended as under:

1.	<p><i>On receipt of a complaint of mass scale failure (at least 90% failure in a paper(s) from Principals/ Director/ HOD of Institutions, the Vice Chancellor can order fresh evaluation of that paper(s). If after fresh evaluation, variation of 15% or more marks is reported in the awards given by both the examiners in at least 50% of the candidates, then the results of such candidates shall be revised and declared by following the rules as applicable in rules meant for re-evaluation, otherwise the awards given by the original examiner shall hold good.</i></p>	<p><i>1- In case more than 75% students in a particular course/subject/paper of an Institution/College/Department are declared fail and Principal/ Director/HOD of Institution makes a written complaint along with a fees of Rs 50/- per student as security within 15 days of declaration of result regarding evaluation of such subject/course to the Controller of Examination, then the Vice-Chancellor can order fresh evaluation.</i></p> <p><i>2- After such evaluation if (i) the variation of more than 15% of maximum marks is reported in at least 50% of the students and (ii) there is change of status of result of 20% students then the original evaluator may be debarred for evaluation for three years.</i></p> <p><i>3- In case both conditions mentioned at 2(i) and 2(ii) are not satisfied after the complaint then the security money deposited by the Principal/ Director/ HOD of Institution/College/ Department shall be forfeited else it shall be refunded.</i></p> <p><i>4- Out of original evaluation & 2nd evaluation the better of two scores shall be awarded to the students in case condition 2(i) & 2(ii) are both satisfied otherwise original result shall stand valid.</i></p>
