Copy of extract of Reso. No. 5 of Academic Council's Meeting held on 11.02.2026.

5. Ratification of the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor, in amending the eligibility conditions for admission to PG Diploma in Karmakanda for the session 2025-26 as under and running of the course with a minimum no. of 10 students for the promotion of IKS (Indian Knowledge System) in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council:

"Bachelor Degree in any discipline with at least 45% marks in aggregate (42.75% in case of SC/ST/Blind/ Visually /Differently abled etc. candidates of Haryana only) or any other examination recognized by MDU Rohtak as equivalent thereto. Preference will be given to the students who passed Shastri Examination"

The Director, Centre for Maharshi Dayanand & Vedic Studies forwarded the proceedings of the meeting of Adhoc PGBOS held on 12.07.2025 vide letter dated 11.08.2025 (Annexure A/5 pages 188-189, already circulated) vide which relaxation in eligibility conditions and running the Diploma with minimum 10 students has been recommended.

It is relevant to mention here that as per Prospectus for admission to PG Diploma in Karmakanda of the session 2025-26, the eligibility condition for admission was as under:

"Bachelor Degree in Sanskrit/Shastri with atleast 45% marks in aggregate (42.75% in case of SC/ST/Blind/ Visually/Differently abled etc. candidates of Haryana only) in aggregate or any other examination recognized by MDU Rohtak as equivalent thereto. Preference will be given to the students passed Shastri Examination"

It was also made in the Prospectus that Certificate courses/ PG Diploma Programs will be offered only if there is a minimum admission of 50% of the sanctioned intake and the sanctioned intake of the course were 40.

Further, the PGBOS vide Reso. No. 3 also resolved that PG Diploma Program in Karmakanda for the session 2025-26 may be allowed to be run with a minimum no. of 10 students for the promotion to Indian Knowledge System (IKS) (Annexure A/6 page 190, already circulated).

The matter was considered by the Vice-Chancellor, who approved the above recommendation in the interest of the students, in anticipation of approval of the Academic Council and same has been notified to the quarter concerned vide letter No. AC-1/AN/2025-22315 dated 22.08.2025 (Annexure A/7 pages 191-192, already circulated) as the Director, Centre for Maharshi Dayanand & Vedic Studies has stated that the meeting of the concerned faculty is not going to be held in near future and the matter is very urgent because it is related to admissions.

The Academic Council considered the above; and

With due respect it is stated that the Centre for Maharshi Dayanand and Vedic Studies offered PG Diploma in Karmakanda with an intake of 40 seats for the session 2025-26. The Centre received 07 applications for admission to this diploma program.

Several students, showing an interest in pursuing the program represented for relaxation in the condition of Sanskrit subject at level of bachelor's degree (Original applications enclosed). These requests were put before the adhoc PGBOS for the Centre for Maharshi Dayanand and Vedic Studies. The Board discussed the requests received from the several applicants regarding consideration of their applications for admission to PG Diploma in Karmakanda by relaxing the condition of Sanskrit subject in bachelor's degree.

After thorough discussion and keeping in view the provisions made of two Skill Enhancement Courses (संस्कृत भाषा परिचय - 1 and संस्कृत भाषा परिचय - 2) in the revised syllabi and scheme of PG Diploma in Karmakanda with effect from the session 2025-26, the Board resolved that the eligibility for admission to PG Diploma in Karmakanda may be revised w.e.f. the session 2025-26 as under:

"Bachelor Degree in any discipline with at least 45% marks in aggregate (42.75% in case of SC/ST/ Blind/Visually/Differently abled etc. candidates of Haryana only) or any other examination recognized by MDU Rohtak as equivalent thereto. Preference will be given to the students who passed Shastri examination."

The Board further resolved that the applications for admission to PG Diploma in Karmakanda may be reinvited with revised eligibility and the PG Diploma in

2. The Board discussed the requests received from the several applicants regarding consideration of their application for admission to PG Diploma in Karmakanda by relaxing the condition of Sanskrit subject in bachelor's degree.

Keeping in view the provisions made of two Skill Enhancement Courses (संस्कृतभाषापरिचय - 1 and संस्कृतभाषापरिचय - 2) in the revised syllabi and scheme of PG Diploma in Karmakanda with effect from the session 2025-26, the Board, after through discussion resolved that the eligibility for admission to PG Diploma in Karmakanda may be revised w.e.f. the session 2025-26 as under:






