Ir engineer suspended over absence amid waterlogging

Gurgaon: MCG has suspended junior engineer Manoj for allegedly remaining absent from the field and unavailable during waterlogging in ward 14 following rainfall on Friday.

Manoj was responsible for monitoring the waterlogging situation and ensuring timely deployment of the required machinery, manpower and dewatering arrangements. The suspension order, issued by MCG commissioner Pradeep Dahiya, states that the junior engineer's phone was found switched off and no response or assistance was received from him. It further states that he had left headquarters without permission. The civic body said his absence during the emergency adversely affected the timely response to the waterlogging problem and caused inconvenience and hardship to the public.

The order states that the junior engineer's conduct prima facie constituted gross negligence, dereliction of duty, lack of devotion to duty, disobedience of official directions and conduct unbecoming of a municipal employee. Taking into account the seriousness of the lapses, the commissioner placed Manoj under suspension with immediate effect under the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 2016, pending disciplinary proceedings.

During the suspension, Manoj's headquarters has been fixed at the office of the executive officer, municipal council, Sohna.

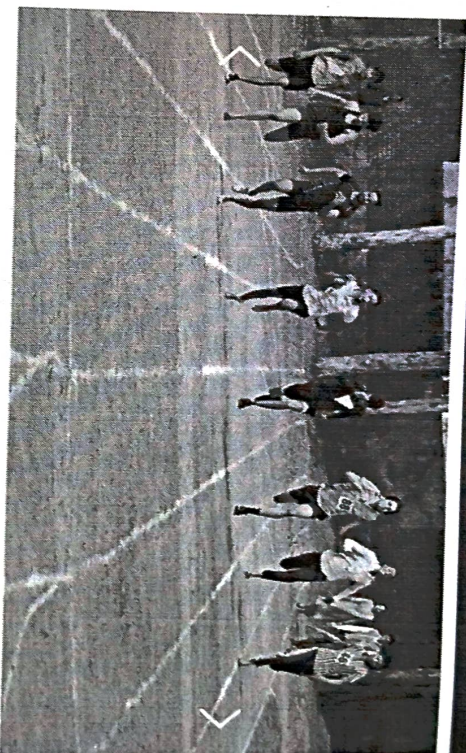

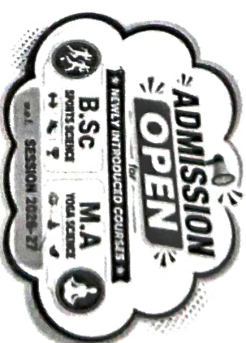
