

M.A. Psychology (Semester III & IV)

(Session 2020–2021)

In Semester III, there would be three core papers (two theory papers and a practical) and two discipline specific papers. In Semester IV there would be two core papers (one theory paper and one practical) and three discipline specific courses. Each student has to opt for the discipline specific papers from **one group only, i.e. 1: Clinical & Abnormal Psychology, 2: Guidance & Counselling; 3: Industrial & Personnel Psychology**. Each Student will opt for at least one open elective course (minimum 3 credits) in Semester III.

DISSERTATION / PROJECT REPORT

(Only applicable to foreign students)

Course Outcomes

Learning Objectives:

- Students would be familiarized with the process involved in conduct of empirical research in Psychology.
- To familiarize students with planning, reporting and interpreting data in the domain specific areas.
- Equipping students with the field based empirical knowledge.

Marks: Dissertation: 100
(Evaluation 75; Viva-Voce: 25)

The dissertation/Project Report will be completed under the supervision of a teacher in the Department. Dissertation maximum marks = 100 (75 for evaluation and 25 for viva-voce). The evaluation of dissertation and viva-voce examination shall be conducted by the board of examiners consisting of one external examiner and the supervisor of the candidate. In case there is a dispute, the Head of Department will act as moderator and her/his decision will be final.
