A Departmental Committee meeting was held on 9th December, 2019 at 10.00 PM in the office of Head, Department of Biochemistry. Following members were present in the meeting:






Departmental Committee considered the agenda circulated via e-mail on 06/12/2019. Following observations were made regarding reconsideration request of Dr. CS Pundir.


A. Departmental Committee has reviewed the reconsideration request of Dr. CS Pundir and following observations were made.


- I. He is highly un-cooperative and discourages young faculties to pursue research in biosensor field and didn't share major facilities with the Departmental faculties and students.
- II. A number of sophisticated and expensive instruments are in the possession of Dr. CS Pundir, which are not accessible to the Departmental research scholars and faculties. That limits the proper utilization of university facilities.
- III. Dr. CS Pundir is not contributing to the growth and interest of the Department as his focus is on to fulfill his personal aspirations.
- IV. He usually permits unknown peoples to work in the lab without any intimation to the Department; these malpractices could invite the problems in the Departmental function.
- V. Moreover, in compliance with terms and conditions given in the guidelines of Professor Emeritus at point No 1, Professor Emeritus cannot be awarded without recommendations of the departmental committee.
- VI. Department is already finding difficult to manage space for teaching PG and PhD Classes as well as for pursuing research. Under such circumstances extension for Emeritus Professor cannot be recommended at the cost of space and facilities for the regular teachers already working in the Department.


Departmental Committee is the best judge to evaluate and safeguard the interests of the Department. In view of above observations, Department committee stays with its previous recommendation (meeting held on 22nd July 2019) and out rightly rejects reconsideration request of Dr. CS Pundir. DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE DOES NOT RECOMMEND THE EXTENSION OF PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF Dr CS Pundir.
