Dear Sir/Madam,

I am directed to state that in pursuance of insertion of clauses 15(6) and 16(6) in the Constitution of India vide the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019 and in order to enable the Economic Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes (SC) and Schedule Tribes (ST) and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC), the Government of India has decided to provide reservation in admission to educational institutions (barring minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of the Article 30 of the Constitution of India) subject to a maximum of 10% of the total seats in each category.

In this regard, the Council of Architecture is in receipt of letter dated 17.01.2019 issued by Ministry of HRD in the matter, (copy enclosed for ready reference), addressed to various statutory bodies as well as to Chief secretaries of all State Governments/UTs, for giving effect to provisions of Constitutional amendment towards reservation for EWS for all higher educational institutions.

In addition, the Council has been receiving requests/representations from various institutions and admission authorities for increase in sanctioned intake in order to provide for reservations for EWS in admission in B.Arch. course.

The Council, after having considered the matter, has decided to increase the number of seats in B.Arch. degree course over and above the annual sanctioned intake at institutions approved by the Council for imparting 5-year B.Arch. Degree course during the academic session 2019-2020 in order to give effect to provisions of Constitutional amendment towards reservation for EWS, subject to the following:

- The reservation in admissions in B.Arch. course shall be maximum of 10% of total seats in each category.
- The number of seats available excluding those reserved for the person belonging to EWS should not be less than the number of such seats available in each category for the academic session 2018-2019.

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3. The reservation and increase in number of seats in B.Arch. course shall be implemented for institutions (including private educational institutions, whether aided or unaided by the State, other than the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of article 30 of Constitution) in accordance with the provisions made/approved by the respective Central/State Government(s) or its competent admission authority, subject to maintenance of the Minimum Standards of Architectural Education prescribed by the Council under the Architects Act, 1972.

The reservation and increase in number of seats for each category for admission shall be as per the notification/order/approval of the Central or respective State Government issued in terms of letter dated 17.01.2019 issued by Ministry of HRD.

4. The institutions which are unable to increase their sanctioned intake due to financial, physical or academic limitations or difficulty in maintaining minimum standards of education, may increase the sanctioned intake strength over a period of two years beginning with 2019-2020, subject to approval from the respective Central/State Government or its competent admission authority.

5. The institutions, after providing reservation in admissions for the said categories in the seats created over and above the sanctioned intake, shall submit the following information to the Council for its consideration and records:

- i. The notification/order/approval received from the respective Central/State Government or its competent admission authority, for providing reservation for categories including EWS along with increase in number of seats in B.Arch. course.
- ii. The category-wise admissions made in B.Arch. course by the institution(s) in the following format:

- iii. The compliance made by the institution towards increase in **physical and academic infrastructure and facilities as well as faculty of architecture** vis-a-vis the increase in number of seats in B.Arch. course for providing reservation for EWS, in order to meet the minimum standards prescribed by the Council.



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6. The Council may, at any point in time, undertake inspection of any institution providing reservation in admissions for the said categories in order to assess the maintenance of the minimum standards of architectural education. In case any institution is found to be imparting deficient education, the sanctioned intake of such institution shall be reduced by the Council commensurately in the ensuing academic session.

In view of the above, your good offices are requested to kindly direct the concerned authorities in your state to facilitate reservation for EWS at architectural institutions imparting 5-year B.Arch. degree course as per the conditions mentioned above, duly ensuring maintenance of minimum standards of architectural education by institutions as prescribed by the Council from time to time. Further, architectural institutions may also be directed to submit information/compliance as mentioned above to the Council after providing for reservation for EWS, for its records and for initiating any further appropriate action.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for admission in Central Educational Institutions.

In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act 2019, and the reference of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment vide OM No. 20013/01/2016-BC-II dated 17th January 2019, enabling provision of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes, it has been decided to provide reservation in admission to educational institutions subject to a maximum of ten per cent of the total seats in each category. This would not apply to the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of Article 30 of the Constitution of India.

2. The provision of reservations to the Economically Weaker Sections shall be in accordance with the directions contained in the OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17th January 2019 of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment and shall be subject to the following:

- a) The reservations shall be provided to EWSs for admission in Central Educational Institutions, (as defined in clause (d) of section (2) of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006) from the academic year 2019-20 onwards.
- b) The above reservation would not be applicable to the 8 institutions of excellence, research institutions, institutions of national & strategic importance as specified in the Schedule to The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006, as amended from time to time, and appended to this OM, and to the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of article 30 of the Constitution.
- c) Every Central Educational Institution shall, with the prior approval of the appropriate authority (as defined in clause (c) of section 2 of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006), increase the number of seats over and above its annual permitted strength in each branch of

study or faculty so that the number of seats available, excluding those reserved for the persons belonging to the EWSs, is not less than the number of such seats available, in each category, for the academic session immediately preceding the date of the coming into force of this O.M.

- d) Where, on a representation by any Central Educational Institution, the appropriate authority is satisfied that for reasons of financial, physical or academic limitations or in order to maintain the standards of education, the annual permitted strength in any branch of study or faculty of such institution cannot be increased for the academic session following the commencement of this Act, it may permit such institution to increase the annual permitted strength over a maximum period of two years beginning with the academic session following the commencement of this Act; and then, the extent of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections shall be limited for that academic session in such manner that the number of seats made available to the Economically Weaker Sections for each academic session shall not reduce the number and the percentage of reservations provided for SC/ST/OBC categories.
- e) The scheme for implementing the reservation for the EWS shall be displayed on the website of the institution as soon as possible, but no later than 31st March 2019.

3. The Chairman UGC, Chairman AICTE and Chairperson NCTE and the Bureau Heads of the Department of Higher Education in the Ministry of Human Resource Development responsible for management of the Institutions of National Importance are requested to ensure immediate compliance of this OM.

4. This issues with the approval of the Minister for Human Resource Development.
