The Committee considered the proposal received from the Director IMSAR with regard to creation of supernumerary seat for Ph.D. Programme from the session 2019-20 for corporate executive having atleast of 10 years experience in company/organization with annual turn over of atleast 300 crore for promoting entrepreneurial and startup culture alongwith the proposal received from HOD (Commerce) (copy enclosed) for creation of one seat in the department of Commerce for Ph.D. Programme on the lines of the proposal of Director, IMSAR.

**Resolved** that the above proposal of Director, IMSAR and HOD (Commerce) be approved from the session 2019-20 and be inserted at sr.No. (vi)(a) in the Ordinance of Ph.D. Programme.

**Further resolved** that the Note-2 as mentioned in the Prospectus at page-25 shall also applicable for the above said category

The merit list will be prepared on the basis of startup experience (2 marks per year subject to maximum 10 marks)

2. The Committee considered the matter in detail and recommended that clause - (viii) of the Ordinance of Ph.D. Programme be amended as under from the session 2019-20:-

<p>(viii) Two supernumerary seats in the Department of Law are earmarked for admission to the candidates who are State Govt. Law Officers or Judges. Such candidates are exempted from entrance test provided that they are otherwise eligible.</p> <p>The Judges shall be considered for admission against this supernumerary seats for admission to Ph.D. Programme. The merit list will be prepared on the basis of experience and one mark for each year subject to maximum 10 marks shall be given for the purpose.</p>	<p>(viii) Two supernumerary seats in the Department of Law are earmarked for admission to the candidates who are Judges.
