## **Syllabus for Entrance Test of MBA (General, Honours and Business Economics) Two Years - 2021**

**Maximum Marks: 100**

The aptitude test shall comprise of four (04) sections:

### **Section 01: English Language Comprehension**

Reading Comprehension, Synonyms and Antonyms, Idioms and Phrases, Para Jumbled, Sentence correction, English Usage Errors, English Grammar, One Word Substitution, Sentence Improvement

### **Section 02: Quantitative Techniques and Data Interpretation**

Number System, Percentages, Profit and Loss, Averages, Partnership, Time-Speed Distance, Work and time, Ratios and Proportion, Alligations & Mixtures, Fraction and Decimals, Geometry, Quadratic and linear equations, Mensuration, Pipes and Cisterns, Simple Interest and Compound Interest, Probability, Permutations & Combinations, Tabulation, Pie chart, Bar Chart, Line Graph

### **Section 03: Logical Reasoning**

Analytical reasoning, Coding-Decoding, Matrix arrangements, Symbol based problems, Sequencing, Number series, Direction and Distance test, Odd-Man Out, Statements and assumptions, Statements Arguments, Cause and effects, Statements and conclusion, Non Verbal Tests (Visual reasoning), Analogy Test, Inferences, Ranking Tests, Linear arrangements, Matrix arrangements, Blood relationship test

### **Section 04: General Awareness**

Current Affairs, Trade Awareness (Corporate news), Personalities in News, History, Culture, Geography, Economy, Polity, Indian Constitution, Sports News, Literature, Science in everyday life

**Note:** A set 100 Multiple Choice Questions comprising 25 question from each section carrying equal marks and bearing Serial No 1 to 100 with four choices namely A, B, C, D (only capital letters) of each question shall be prepared by the Paper Setter. Out of four choices only one option should be correct. The candidates shall be given 90 minutes to attempt these questions. Standard of questions will be as may be expected of a graduate who has not made any special study in any of the areas given above.
