- 1. All the students will be required to follow the national guidelines related to COVID-19 as issued from Ministry of Home affairs/State Govt. time to time.

This shall, however, be subject to production of a valid RTPCR report issued by the Govt./Civil Hospitals only. The test report must be submitted by the student concerned in the Office of Controller of Examinations well before the date of concerned examination otherwise the same shall not be considered.
