### COMPETITION 1: SLOGAN WRITING

#### Rules & Regulations:

- All the participants need to fill registration link
- Only one Participant (one Student) will be allowed per entry
- Slogans should be original and shall not be copied from anywhere, otherwise the participant shall be liable to be disqualified.
- All participants are supposed to write slogan on the spot.
- Dimensions of poster is A3 size (11.7 \* 16.5 inches) sheet which will be provided by the organisers.
- Slogan can be written by using pencil, crayon, watercolour, oil paint, etc. It should be original and hand made.

- The essential material required for slogan writing shall be carried by participants by themselves.
- Slogan should not contain any personal details like Name, Class, College etc. of the participants. These details should be mentioned in registration form only.
- The participants may be required to explain their slogan by the judges.
- All participants must provide a slogan relevant to the theme of the competition in no more than 20 words.
- Slogan must be written in English or Hindi only.
- Message of slogan, design, content and explanation of slogan shall be the merit criteria.
- The decision of the judges shall be final and no sort of disputes shall be entertained.

  - The poster must be made on standard size sheet which will be provided by the organisers.
  - Poster can be made using pencil, crayon, watercolour, oil paint, etc. It should be original and hand made.
  - The essential material required for poster making shall be carried by participants by themselves.
    - Poster should not contain any personal details like Name, Class, College etc. of the participants. These details should be mentioned in registration form only.
    - The participants may be required to explain their poster by the judges.
- All participants must make poster relevant to the theme of the competition only
- Poster shall not contain any message on it Creativity, design, colours and explanation of poster shall be the merit criteria.
- The decision of the judges shall be final and no sort of disputes shall be entertained
