# As cases rise in Hry, Pb ups surveillance

**Chandigarh:** With neighbouring Haryana noting an uptick in the Covid-19 caseload, the Punjab government has issued instructions for scaling up the surveillance to avoid the resurgence of cases in the state.

Punjab, which has been one of the worst-hit states by the pandemic, at the moment is passing through a lull phase. In the last 10 days, 96 cases were reported in Punjab, while only one person succumbed to the virus. The situation in Haryana has started to worsen as during the same period it recorded 1,529 cases and one death. In recent weeks, Haryana and Delhi have been major contributors to the daily national growth rate.

As there has been a significant drop in the caseload, the testing count has also co-

**Chandigarh:** As many as 21 cases of Covid-19 surfaced in Punjab while no death was reported on Tuesday. Ludhiana reported the highest of eight cases while five cases surfaced in Jalandhar, three in Mohali, two in Pathankot and one each in Barnala, Gurdaspur and Patiala. As many as 31,052 individuals were given Covid-19 vaccines.

me down sharply. Between April 1-18, as many as 1,56,186 tests — 8,677 tests per day — were conducted in the state. The health department has set a target of ensuring a minimum of 20,000 tests per day and the civil surgeons have been asked to scale up the testing efforts in their respective

districts. Punjab uses both conventional RT-PCR and rapid antigen tests for detecting the virus. Except for Faridkot, Hoshiarpur and Muktsar, the share of RT-PCR method in the total testing count was more than RAT in the past week.

Punjab health minister Vijay Singla shared that the civil surgeons had been directed to ramp up the number of testing to a desirable level and to also ensure proper contact tracing of the positive cases. "At the moment, the situation is well under control, but we cannot afford to take chances. Instructions have been issued to ensure that all the preventive measures are taken," said Singla, who further urged people to follow protocol and wear masks even though they are not mandatory.

## 14 Covid cases in HP

**Shimla:** Himachal Pradesh reported 14 new Covid-19 positive cases on Tuesday, while 14 persons were declared recovered. The state has so far detected 2,84,712 positive cases, of which 63 are under treatment, 2,80,515 patients have recovered, while 4,115 patients have died. Four districts of state — Bilaspur, Kinnaur, Lahaul-Spiti and Hamirpur and Kangra.

Sirmour — had zero active cases Covid-19 as of Tuesday.

So far 45,87,810 persons have been tested for Covid-19 till date, of which 43,03,094 persons have been tested negative. Positive cases reported include seven from Kangra district, two each from Hamirpur and Shimla, one each Mandi, Solan and Una. Those recovered include four each from Chamba, Hamirpur and Kangra.

unt of the state has 9,87,479 cases, 9,75,475 active cases. Of the 14 patients, only 14 patients were hospitalised.

Gurgaon topped the list with 196 new cases, followed by 40 cases from Karnal. Four cases were reported from Sonapatna, two from Jhajjar and one from Karnal.

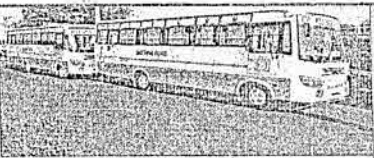

# MC to extend city bus services in Rohtak

Asks contractor to ply five more vehicles to meet public demand | Fare ₹10 per passenger

ROHTAK, APRIL 19 | Keeping in view the public demand, the Municipal Corporation authorities have decided to extend city bus services with cheap fare. It has asked the contractor to buy at least five more buses so as to meet the demand. Five buses on different routes are already plying in the city. Every passenger has to pay Rs 10 as fare to travel in the buses while auto-rickshaw charges Rs 20 per passenger hence people prefer to travel in the buses instead of auto-rickshaw but they have to wait for long at bus queues as their number is normal.

han Goyal said.

He maintained the extension of bus services would not only ensure the facility on several other routes but also keep the city environment clean as it would be operated by CNG. The contractor said he would be buying five more buses soon.

Bisham Sharma, contractor, said they had planned to launch city bus services on the routes of Rohtak Railway Station to the New Bus Stand, Railway Station to the PGIMS, Industrial Area Hisar Road to the Delhi Bypass and Bohar village to the Old Bus Stand.

Besides the city, the bus services are also being provided to some nearby villages that fall under the jurisdiction of the Municipal Corporation. The contractor pays Rs 16,100 per month to the corporation in lieu of running the bus services in the city. The 32-seater compressed natural gas (CNG) buses are plying between Bahiana village to the Old Bus Stand and New Bus Stand to PGIMS in Rohtak.

## Four-year-old killed under school van

**GURUGRAM, APRIL 19** | In a tragic incident, a 4-year-old child died after being crushed under a school van while being dropped home. The police have booked the driver and school management but no arrests have been made so far. The police said the accused driver is still absconding. The school was also locked after the incident.

There was mourning in the family. The family is in shock and is demanding strict action against the school management. On Tuesday, the police handed over the body of the boy to the family after conducting a postmortem examination.

### Driver flees spot in Gurugram

His school van dropped him that he slipped and fell down. Not caring the driver of the van drove the vehicle over the child. He was rushed to the civil lines-based hospital but died.

An FIR was registered against the school management and van driver under Sections 279 (rash driving) and 304 (culpable homicide not amounting to murder) at the Kharki Daula police station.

"My four-year-old son had started going to school 13 days ago and he was very happy. Due to the negligence of the school and the van driver, my son has been taken away from us. The van driver drives the van in speed while he has no helper in the van. After getting information, I reached the spot but the driver had fled after leaving my son in a serious condition on the roadside. The driver did not even wait for my arrival. It was due to the negligence of the school and the driver of the van that my son is not with me today," Gushian, father of deceased student, said.

"We are conducting raids to nab the suspect driver who has not been identified yet. We visited the school today but found it locked and could not contact the management. We are on the job and the accused will be arrested soon," said Inspector Rajender Kumar, SHO of the Kharki Daula police station.

## Man booked for killing wife in Ambala, absconding

**AMBALA, APRIL 19** | The police have booked a man for allegedly killing his wife in Railway Colony of Barana in Ambala on Tuesday. The accused has been identified as Kavita (40), while the accused has been identified as Budhram. A case has been registered on the complaint of deceased's son Rakesh Kumar, who alleged that his father used to have quarrels with her mother over petty issues. Rakesh (19) stated that after the death of Budhram's first wife, he married Kavita, who was a migrant labourer in 2008. After marriage,

Rakesh and his brother came to Barana with their mother and started living in the railway colony. "My father used to have quarrels over petty issues and also suspected her character. Around 3:30 am on Tuesday we heard screams of our mother and when we went to check on her, we saw our father hitting her with an iron rod," Rakesh alleged. After lifting Kavita, Budhram fled from the spot. Kavita was rushed to a private hospital where she died while undergoing treatment. ASI Arjit Kumar said, "Efforts are on to nab the accused." — TNS
