35. Amendment to Clause – 6 of General Rules of Examinations

Considered the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor under Section 9A (5) of MDU Act in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council/Executive Council, for replacing the existing clause as provided in General Rules of Examinations under Clause 6 as under as recommended by a Committee (Annexure A/47 page 327, already circulated):

<p>Clause 6. A candidate's examination form and fee may be accepted after the last date with late fee as prescribed upto the date notified by the University. The examination form may also be accepted upto 30 days before the commencement of the Examination (subject to discretion of the Controller of Examinations) with late fee as prescribed by the University. The period of 30 days is to be counted from the date of commencement of the Examination given in the schedule of examination. Postponement of examination, if any, will have no impact upon it.</p> <p>In a very exceptional and hard cases, the Vice-Chancellor when he/she deems it appropriate may allow as a special case to accept the examination form 7 days prior to commencement of the examination with a late fee of Rs. 5000/-.</p>	<p>Clause 6. 	<p>6 (1). With late fee of Rs. 10,000/- per semester/year for accepting the examination forms between seven days to one day before commencement of the examinations.</p>
