The Committee deliberated upon the agenda, especially the details of admission procedure for admission to MA (JMC) for the session 2021- 2022.

After detailed discussions, it was unanimously decided as under:

1. That the mode of admission to MA (JMC)- Previous for the session 2021- 2022 may be through ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (WRITTEN TEST- OFFLINE)
2. That the Syllabi for the Entrance Test may be as under:

3. The Intake for MA (JMC) for the session 2021- 2022 be increased to 35 from earlier 30. This excludes the supernumerary seats which would be in addition to the prescribed seats. Keeping in view the COVID situation, it was felt that further increase in seats is not desirable especially keeping in view the spatial constraints of class room.
  4. Further, to encourage genuine students with keen interest in Journalism & Mass Communication, Weightage to the students of Journalism & Mass Communication background at UG Level be given as under:
