Stakeholders Feedback Analysis for Session 2020-21

Key Takeaways

- Feedback received from 3254 students pertaining to overall all academic environment using 22 statements at 4-point scale and found the responses in the range of "Good to Excellent" which clearly depicts that student are very much satisfied with the current academic environment provided by the University.
- Feedback analysis of 1725 parents and 2398 Alumni received on 14 parameters each
 concomitant to academic environment, found the responses in "Excellent" only which
 infers that parents and alumni both are completely satisfied.
- 3. Feedback analysis of 1725 employers received on 16 parameters concomitant to competencies and quality of the students, and here too got the responses in "Excellent" only which infers that employers too are completely satisfied.
- 4. Feedback analysis of 136 teachers received on 19 parameters concomitant to conducive environment of teaching and learning and found the responses in "Excellent" only (except one) which infers that teachers too are completely satisfied.
- Besides above findings, some suggestions have also been received from all the stakeholder like:
 - Students suggested that more placements avenues should be made available to the students and teaching learning process should be more interactive in nature.
 - Parents suggested that more focus should be given to the placements.
 - Alumni suggested that more proactive alumni interaction should be organized.
 - Employer suggested that more attention should be paid to practical knowledge.
 - Teachers said that coordinated efforts and teamwork needs to be strengthened.

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1. Analysis of Feedback from Students

Feedback obtained by University Teaching Departments (UTDs) was put before the Quality Advisory Council of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). On the basis of the feedback so obtained, the quantitative analysis observed by the Council is presented in Table I. This feedback was obtained on a scale of 1 to 4 from 3254 students. The categorization of rating based on mean score (S) of different parameters is as follows: Excellent ($3 \le S \le 4$), Good ($2 \le S \le 3$), Satisfactory ($1.5 \le S \le 2$), and Needs Improvement ($S \le 1.5$).

The feedback received from students clearly depicts that students are very much satisfied on the 22 parameters pertaining to the quality of course content, knowledge base of the teachers, fairness of internal assessment, library support, support from the administrative staff, career counselling and placement facility, co-curricular activities and extracurricular activities, accessibility of the teachers, performance evaluation methods, communication skills of the teachers, teaching pedagogy etc.

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2. Analysis of Feedback from Parents

The parents' feedback was obtained and analysed. Feedback was obtained from 1725 parents on a scale of 1 to 4. The categorization of rating based on mean score (S) of different parameters is as follows: Excellent ($3 \le S \le 4$), Good ($2 \le S \le 3$), Satisfactory ($1.5 \le S \le 2$), and unsatisfactory ($S \le 1.5$).

Feedback received from parents on 14 parameters pertaining to admission process, learning environment, placement facilities, improvement in the performance of their ward, behaviour of the teaching and non-teaching staff, and discipline revealed that parents are also very much satisfied as they rated to all with excellent.

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3. Analysis of Alumni Feedback

Maharshi Dayanand University incorporates alumni feedback to improve the quality of academic programs especially for design and review of syllabus. Feedback was obtained from 2398 alumni on a scale of 1 to 4.

Feedback received from alumni on 14 parameters pertaining to the quality of academic programs, library facilities, cooperative behaviour of the staff, infrastructure and lab facilities, involvement of alumni in university activities, new and contemporary courses, knowledge and expertise of the faculty, fee structure etc revealed that alumni rated excellent to all the 14 parameters.

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4. Analysis of Employer Feedback

Many graduates of Maharshi Dayanand University have been working in different types of organizations. Feedback was received from 60 employers on 1 to 4 scale regarding 16 parameters while their overall stratification level was assessed.

Feedback received from employer on 16 parameters pertaining to general communication skill, ability to contribute to the goal of the organization, obligation to work beyond schedule if required, and open to new ideas and learning new techniques, technical skill, innovativeness and creativity, relationship with the peer as well as with the seniors was also rated as excellent by all the employers. The employer suggested that skilled calm, devotee and progressive approach should be there in the university.

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5. Teachers Feedback Analysis

Feedback from 136 teachers was collected mainly for their views towards, the curriculum, teaching, learning and evaluation system using 1 to 4 scale. Total 19 parameters were used for this purpose, the results derived in terms of percentage of teachers with common views, mean score and rating are presented in Table 5.

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Feedback received from teachers on 19 parameters clearly shows that the majority of teachers rated as excellent to the all the parameters like the freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching such as seminar presentations, group discussions and learners' participation in a similar tune, that aims and objectives of the syllabi were well defined and clear to teachers and students and availability of sufficient numbers of prescribed books in Library, procedure followed for acquiring new books and journals ensures right titles and journals in the library, effectiveness of evaluation system followed by the University, friendliness of administration, ability of University to admit meritorious students and adequacy of support provided by the University for projects and research facilities etc.

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
