The petitioner-university has preferred this writ petition essentially in challenge to the Recognition Order dated 25.03.2022, whereby it was granted recognition/permission for B.P. Ed./M.P. Ed. Courses from the Academic Session 2023-2024. The request of the university had been for granting recognition from the Academic Session 2022-2023 but, the representation made in that regard was also rejected by the respondent-NCTE by its order dated 13.04.2022 that reads as under:-

It has been submitted that the recognition has been  
denied for the Session 2022-2023 for no fault of the  
petitioner-university. Various orders passed by this Court in  
relation to other similarly circumstanced institutions have  
been referred to and relied upon, including the order dated  
08.08.2022 in W.P.(C) No. 505 of 2022, wherein this Court,  
*inter alia*, observed and directed as under:-

"After hearing learned counsel appearing for the  
parties, we are inclined to dispose of the writ  
petition as follows:

(i) The cut-off date fixed by this Court in *Maa  
Vaishno Devi Mahila Mahavidyalaya v. State of Uttar  
Pradesh and Others* (2013) 2 SCC 617, is extended in  
the facts of these cases.

(ii) It is held and declared that the petitioners  
would be entitled to the recognition granted by  
respective orders passed by NCTE or its Regional  
Committees from the Academic Session 2022-23  
instead of Academic Session 2023-24.

(iii) The Respondent-NCTE and its Regional  
Committees are directed to issue formal  
orders/notifications in that regard within a period  
of three days from today.



(iv) The State and other Authorities would consider grant of affiliation and/or other requisite permissions within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order after carrying out of the necessary inspection.

(v) We make it clear that subject to the grant of affiliation and other requisite permissions been granted, the petitioner would be entitled to admit the students for Academic Session 2022-23 as per the sanction granted by NCTE for the Academic Session 2023-24.

(vi) The name of the petitioner-colleges/institutions shall be included in the counselling programme for admissions."

The position aforesaid, which necessary variations, apply to the present petitioner too and we find no reason to deny the same relief to the petitioner.

Accordingly, this writ petition is allowed in the following terms: -

(i) The cut-off date fixed by this Court in *Maa Vaishno Devi Mahila Mahavidyalaya v. State of Uttar Pradesh and Others* (2013) 2 SCC 617, is extended in the facts of this case.

(ii) It is held and declared that the petitioners would be entitled to the recognition granted by respective orders passed by NCTE or its Regional Committees from the Academic Session 2022-23 instead of Academic Session 2023-24.

(iii) The Respondent-NCTE and its Regional Committees are directed to issue formal orders/notifications in that regard within a period of three days from today.

(iv) We make it clear that subject to the grant



of other requisite permissions, the petitioner would be entitled to admit the students for Academic Session 2022-23 as per the sanction granted by NCTE for the Academic Session 2023-24.

All pending applications stand disposed of.

1. The cut-off date fixed by this court in *Maa Vaishno Devi Mahila Mahavidyalaya v. State of Uttar Pradesh and Other* (2013) 2 SCC 617, is extended in the facts of this case.
2. It is held and declared that the petitioners would be entitled to the recognition granted by respective orders passed by NCTE or its Regional Committees from the Academic Session 2022-23 instead of Academic Session 2023-24.
3. The Respondent-NCTE and its Regional Committees are directed to issue formal orders / notification in that regard within a period of three days today.
4. We make it clear that subject to the grant of other requisite permissions, the petitioner would be entitled to admit the students for Academic Session 2022-23 as per the sanction granted by NCTE for the Academic Session 2023-24.

In compliance of the order dated 07.09.2022 the Committee decided to issue a modified recognition order to change the Academic Session 2022-2023 instead of Academic Session 2023-2024 for B.P.Ed.

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak - Delhi Road, Village Town City - Rohtak, Post Office - MDU Campus, Rohtak Tehsil Taluk - Rohtak, Town City - Rohtak District - Rohtak, Haryana, for conducting B.P.Ed. (one basic unit of 100 students) / M.P.Ed. (one basic unit of 40 students) courses from the Academic Session 2023-2024 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 vide order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-10660-10661-B.P.Ed./M.P.Ed. 365<sup>th</sup> (Vol II) (Blended Mode) Meeting/2022/21720-728 dated 25.03.2022.

AND WHEREAS, in compliance of the Order dated 7<sup>th</sup> September 2022 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P.(Civil) No. 473 of 2022 regarding granting of recognition for B.P.Ed./M.P.Ed. courses from the Academic Session 2022-2023 instead of Academic Session 2023-2024. Accordingly, matter was considered by NRC in its 376<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022 and the committee decided to issue a modified order to change the Academic Session 2022-2023 instead of Academic Session 2023-2024.

Now, therefore, recognition for conducting B.P.Ed. / M.P.Ed. courses is hereby granted to Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak, Haryana and the institution is entitled to admit the students for the Academic Session 2022-23 as per the sanction granted by the NCTE for the Academic Session 2023-24 under clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulation, 2014 as amended from time to time, subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned in the Recognition Order dated 25<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

The other contents of the Recognition Order NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-10660-10661-B.P.Ed./M.P.Ed. 365<sup>th</sup> (Vol. II) Blended Mode Meeting/2022/21720-728 dated 25.03.2022 shall remain unchanged.


