**34. Consideration of Amendment to Clause-2 of the Common Ordinance for 5-year Integrated Courses**

The University has a provision under Common Ordinance for three year Courses that a student who has passed B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./BBA, may appear in additional subject(s) of B.A. (Pass Course) in the subsequent examination except in the subject(s) with which he/she has already passed the three year Degree Course. But, the students who have been awarded Bachelor's degree after three Academic years under Common Ordinance for 5-year Integrated Programs are not allowed to appear in additional subject(s). On receipt of a representation from a candidate, the matter was examined by the Academic Branch and it was found that the students who have received Bachelor's degree under Common Ordinance for three Year were allowed to appear in additional subject(s) but the students who have passed same Bachelor's degree under Common Ordinance for 5-year course was not allowed by the University.

Accordingly, the following amendment to Clause-2 of the Common Ordinance for 5-year Integrated Courses was proposed:

The whole matter was placed before the Vice-Chancellor, who has ordered to place the same before the Academic Council/Executive Council for consideration and approval.

The Academic Council vide Reso. No. 39 of its meeting held on 19.10.2022 has considered the matter and recommended the following:
