**MINUTES OF THE EMERGENT MEETING OF THE SUB-ADMISSION COMMITTEE UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF DEAN ACADEMIC AFFAIRS HELD ON 09.06.2023 AT 10:00 A.M. IN THE COMMITTEE ROOM, ADJACENT TO THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR, M.D. UNIVERSITY, ROHTAK TO DISCUSS THE VARIOUS ISSUES REGARDING ADMISSIONS FOR THE SESSION 2023-24:**

The Committee considered the various issues regarding the admissions for the year 2023-24 in the University and gave the following recommendations:

1. The Committee considered the request received through e-mail from CPA to COE regarding clarification about medium of Entrance Examination of LL.M. After discussing the issue with the Dean, Faculty of Law and the representative of HoD, Law the Committee resolved that the medium of Entrance Examination of LL.M may be English only. The Committee further resolved that the medium of Entrance Examination of Forensic Science may also be English only like the programs of Life Sciences and Physical Sciences.
2. The Committee considered the request of HoD, Pharmaceutical Sciences regarding the One Application Form for all branches of M. Pharm. After detailed discussion the Committee resolved that in present scenario, the request of HoD, Pharmaceutical Sciences cannot be acceded to. However from the next session i.e. 2024-25 there may be one form for admissions to various branches of M. Pharm.
3. In previous meeting of the Committee held on 05.06.2023 a proposal of creation of 10 % Supernumerary Seats in all programs except those which are governed by regulatory bodies for the applicants belonging to states/UTs other than Haryana was recommended but this recommendation was referred back by the worthy Vice-Chancellor for clarification whether the candidates outside the State of Haryana will have to apply separately for the proposed Supernumerary Seats.  
The Committee reconsidered its earlier recommendation and resolved as under:  
10% Supernumerary Seats in all programs except those which are governed by the regulatory bodies such as AICTE/ PCI etc. may be created for the applicants belonging to States/ UTs other than Haryana. These Supernumerary Seats may be filled up as per merit of entrance examination from the applicants who belong to outside the State of Haryana and have applied in All India Open Category but could not get admission in the category.
4. The Committee considered the request received from the HoD, Physical Education regarding the dates of Physical Efficiency Test and resolved that since the last date for receiving of applications has been extended up to 16.06.2023, so the dates of Physical Efficiency Test may be rescheduled as under:
  - a) P.E.T. for M.P.Ed. at gymnasium Hall - 20.06.2023 from 09:00 A.M. onward.
  - b) P.E.T. for B.P.Ed. at gymnasium Hall - 21.06.2023 from 09:00 A.M. onward.

5. The Committee considered the note submitted by the Academic Branch regarding the correction in timings of Entrance Test for M.A. Fine Arts (Drawing & Painting) (2-Year Program) and resolved that the time schedule of the Entrance Test for M.A. Fine Arts (Drawing & Painting) (2-Year Program) may be from 12.30 pm to 4.00 pm instead of 12.30 pm to 1.45 pm, as per bifurcation bellow. There is no change in the date of the Entrance Test.
