15 years on, corruption case over Cong-era discom tender

FIR Mentions Allegations About Surjewala 'Misusing Position'

Gurgaon: The state anti-corruption bureau has registered a case against seven persons, including five officials of discom DHBVN, for alleged corruption in awarding a tender for outsourcing skilled manpower in 2009.

This was the year the Congress regime led by Bhupinder Singh Hooda won a second successive term in the state. The FIR makes a mention of allegations that senior Congress functionary Randeep Singh Surjewala, who was then the state power minister. "misused his official position". It does not name Surjewala among the accused.

The tender was awarded to a company, allegedly in violation of terms and conditions of the tender. The company that received the tender did not have the required licence or mandatory expertise prescribed under the eligibility criteria for the tender, according to the ACB. Three out of the five discom officials named in the FIR have retired from service.

But why an FIR after 15 years? One reason cited is that the investigation began only in 2018, and it took several years. "The allegation was that then power minister Randeep Singh Surjewala misused his official position to help Sandhu Security Services contract from DHBVN despite the fact they were not eligible as per the criteria set in the tender," is

WHAT THE VIOLATION WAS

Terms & conditions of the tender required the bidder to have:

A valid licence issued by the labour commissioner

Experience in providing services of 25 skilled, technical personnel for a period of at least two years

Sandhu Services neither had a valid licence nor the required experience

bour commissioner of Haryana before submission of the tender. The bidder should also have provided services to a minimum of 25 skilled technical personnel for a period of at least two years.

The inquiry revealed that Sandhu Security Services had a licence for supplying labour like carpenters, mason, beldar, welder, cook-cum-attendant, etc to National Institute of Technology, Kurukshetra. So. it only had experience in supplying unskilled labour.

On the date of opening the tender, Sandhu Security Services did not have a licence to supply labour to DHBVN, according to ACB. The firm did not have experience in providing skilled technical personnel for a period of at least two years. "The rules of terms and conditions of the tender were violated," said the inquiry report. Sumer Singh, VK Aggarwal, Daljit Singh and Ashok Mehta were held responsible.

Moreover, the requirement of DHBVN was 168 personnel while the licence submitted with the bid was for 53 personnel, that too for NIT Kurukshetra. During the course of the investigation, according to ACB, it was found that 15 SAs were made to pay Rs 2,800-Rs 3,500 as a security deposit by someone from the firm for which no receipt was given.

After completion of the inquiry, the office of the director-general, ACB, in Nov forwarded it to ACB Gurgaon with a recommendation for registration of FIR.

The case was registered under section 120B (criminal conspiracy) of IPC and sections 13(2) and 13(1)D of the Prevention of Corruption Act on Dec5at ACB Gurgaon by DSP Bhartendra Kumar. Besides the discom officials, it mentions M S Sandhu Security Services, Ajay Sandhu and Ishwar Singh, partners of the firm.
