The Committee deliberated over the various issues regarding the admissions for the session 2024-25 in the University and gave the following recommendations:-

1. To consider the proposal made by the Head, Department of Mathematics vide office note dated 14.05.2024 regarding change in the nomenclature of the programme from M.Sc. Mathematics with Computer Science (SFS) to M.Sc. Mathematics (SFS) in the light the - 100P- 2020.

The Admission sub-Committee invited HoD Mathematics for deliberations regarding change of nomenclature of M.Sc Mathematics with Computer Science to M.Sc (Maths). After deliberations, the committee resolved that the item may be referred back to the Department of Mathematics for re-submitting the proposal after following due procedure.

2. Creation of 10% supernumerary seats for All India Category in 2-Year PG Programs as well as 4-Year UG Programs other than those programs under Regulatory Bodies ((BCI/PCU/AICTE.NCTE ETC.)

The Committee recommends that 10% supernumerary seats in all programs except those which are governed by regulatory bodies may be created for the applicants belonging to States/UTs other than Haryana. These supernumerary seats will be filled up as per merit of entrance exam from the applicants who applied in All India Open Category (AIOC) provided that such applicants secure minimum 40% marks in entrance exam.

This provision may also be made applicable for the current admission process underway of 4 year UG programmes and a corrigendum may also be issued.

3. Any other item:

(i) Regarding admission to M.Pharma Programme.

Before applying admission to M.Pharm. programme, the candidate must ensure that he/she is eligible for the same and will submit the proof of completion of B.Pharm. by 30th September, 2024. No candidate who is appearing in 7th semester will be considered eligible for admission to M.Pharm. programme. Only those candidates who are appearing in the examination of 8th semester and their result will be declared latest by 30th September, 2024 OR have already passed B.Pharm. may apply.
