REVISED NOTIFICATION

The Vice-Chancellor has been pleased to re-establish the Anti-Ragging Committee regarding curbing the menace of Ragging. Ragging is totally prohibited in the University and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished in accordance with the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and "The Haryana Prohibition of Ragging in Educational Institution Ordinance, 2012" as well as under the provisions of any penal law for the time being in force.

	Respective Heads/ Directors of the UTDs/ Centers/ Institutes shall ensure constitution of Mentoring Cell at the Department/ Center/ Institute level as per UGC Guidelines and place the same on the Department page of the University Website. The respective UGC Guidelines for constitution of Mentoring Cell are as under:- “Mentoring Cell consisting of students volunteering to be Mentors for freshers, in the succeeding academic year; and there shall be as many levels or tiers of mentors as the number of batches in the institution, at the rate of one mentor for six fresher and one mentor of a higher level for six mentors of lower level.”

We are also glad to convey that with the determined and sincere efforts of our senior students and faculty, our campus has been free from the menace of Ragging.

HODs/Directors of all the University Teaching Departments/Centres/Institutes to ensure that every student and their parents be asked to submit an online undertaking every academic year to the effect that the concerned student will not take part in any activity leading to Ragging of junior students.

What Constitutes Ragging: Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- (a) Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- (b) indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- (c) asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- (d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- (e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students;
- (f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- (g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it : sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- (h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, e-mails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- (i) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.
- (j) Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.

- (k) All the senior students are advised to guide and treat junior students affectionately.
- (l) Junior students may contact their HODs/Directors or other University functionaries like Proctor, Dean Students Welfare, Chief Warden, Wardens or Controller Security for help and guidance.


