

Govt to fill 50K vacant posts: CM

Says Group-D jobs also to be made available to the youth, will follow transparent process

Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini today said that 50,000 vacant posts of various categories would be filled soon. Besides, Group-D jobs would also be made available to the youth.

The announcement comes as part of the government's ongoing efforts to provide employment opportunities to the youth and support their aspirations in Haryana.

The Chief Minister, while interacting with mediators after administering the oath of office to Himmat Singh, emphasized the continuation of a transparent recruitment system for government jobs.

HIMMAT SINGH SWORN IN AS HSSC CHAIRMAN

Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini on Saturday administered the oath of office to Himmat Singh, the new chairman of the Haryana Staff Selection Commission (HSSC), at a swearing-in ceremony held at Haryana Niwas.

Before his appointment as HSSC chairman, Himmat Singh had served as Additional

Advocate General, Haryana and expressed hope that he would discharge his new responsibilities with full dedication and meet the aspirations of the state's youth.

The Chief Minister highlighted that during the last nine and a half years, the youth

had shown full faith in the transparent and merit-based recruitment process of the state government and its other welfare policies.

Saini emphasized that Haryana was the only state government that has provided jobs to youth purely on merit without 'kharchi-parchi' (bribery and favouritism).

the matter in the Supreme Court and strongly advocated for it to ensure justice to the youth," he added.

The Chief Minister said that the socio-economic criteria were introduced to provide employment opportunities to members of poor families, who did not have government jobs.

He accused Congress leaders of misleading the public with a false propaganda on the issue. He claimed that Congress leaders were instigating the youth by claiming that their future was bleak, whereas, in reality, it was the future of Congress that was in darkness.

Of four Assembly seats in Ambala dist, BJP led only in Cantt segment

VARUN GOT LEAD IN CM'S HOME TURF NARAINGARH

AMBALA, JUNE 8
Except for the Ambala Cantt Assembly constituency, where the BJP managed to secure a small lead for party candidate Banto Kataria, it had trailed in all other three Assembly segments of Ambala district.

Of the total nine Assembly segments in the Ambala Lok Sabha constituency, the Ambala City, Ambala Cantt, Mullana and Naraingarh Assembly segments come in Ambala district.

While BJP MLAs represent the Ambala City and Ambala Cantt segments, Congress MLAs represent Mullana and Naraingarh in the Assembly.

The Congress had fielded its sitting Mullana MLA Varun Chaudhry in the Lok Sabha elections from the Ambala seat and he won by a margin of 49,036 votes. In the Ambala Cantt segment, led by former Haryana Home Minister Anil Vij, the BJP candidate secured a lead of 2,977 votes. While Banto Kataria polled 61,177 votes, Varun Chaudhry bagged 58,200 votes.

In his home constituency Mullana, Varun secured a lead of 28,118 votes. He polled 86,770 votes while Banto Kataria got 58,652 votes. Similarly, in the Naraingarh constituency, led by Congress MLA Shalji Chaudhary, the Congress candidate secured a lead of 20,906 votes. Varun got 73,347 votes while Banto secured 52,441 votes in Naraingarh, the home turf of Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini. He had won the Naraingarh seat in the 2014 Assembly elections.

BJP Ambala district chief Mandeep Rana said, "We accepted the mandate given by the people of Ambala. Soon,

we will hold a workers' meeting to get feedback and we will work to resolve their issues. We are confident that we will bounce back in the upcoming Assembly elections and win all four Assembly seats in Ambala district."

Meanwhile, speaking to The Tribune, MP-elect Varun said, "The people of Ambala had fought this election and won it as well. I am grateful to party workers and leaders, who had worked hard in the field and also to the people of Ambala who accepted me as their representative. In a couple of days, I will visit all segments to express my gratitude to the voters and the party workers."

Wrong ticket allocation to blame for Cong defeat on Bhiwani-Mahendragarh seat: Kiran

Congress candidate Rao Dan Singh's defeat from the Bhiwani-Mahendragarh Lok Sabha constituency has stirred a row within the party with Tosham MLA Kiran Choudhary finding flaws in the candidate selection process. Dan Singh lost to BJP's Dharambir Singh by 41,510 votes.

The Congress candidate had lost from his home booth where he got only votes of his family members in own Assembly segment Mahendragarh, which he had represented four times, and three other Assembly segments falling in his home district Mahendragarh, Kiran told The Tribune.

The former minister said

this had happened despite massive anti-incumbency against the ruling BJP in Haryana. "Apparently, it was arrogance that led to the party's defeat despite the fact that there has been positive political vibes across the state for the Congress," she claimed.

Kiran said that there was strategic miscalculation in the selection of the candidates for the Bhiwani-Mahendragarh and Gurugram Lok Sabha constituencies. She claimed that her daughter and former MP Shruti Choudhary would have won the Bhiwani-Mahendragarh seat by an emphatic margin had she been given the ticket.

"We were never called to party meetings and were

never involved in the campaign. This despite the fact that I am the Congress MLA from Tosham and Shruti is the working president of the state Congress," she said. "I had brought the matter to the notice of the party high command during campaigning," she added.

About Dan Singh's performance in his home constituency Mahendragarh, where he lost by 4,840 votes, Kiran said it was shocking that the Congress nominee trailed in his own Assembly constituency and even in his home booth.

"The poll data indicates that Rao Dan Singh, who belongs to Mahendragarh district, has lost in all four Assembly constituencies of the district. However, he led in three of the five Assembly segments

in Bhiwani and Charkhi Dabri districts," she added.

Kiran recalled that Shruti had trailed in the Tosham Assembly segment by 36,000 votes during the 2019 Lok Sabha poll when she was the Congress candidate. "But still, Congress workers in Tosham covered this deficit to a major extent and reduced this loss margin to 8,063 votes. Thus, I can't be blamed for the defeat," she said.

Kiran had not campaigned for Rao Dan Singh in the Bhiwani-Mahendragarh segment though she went to Sirsa district to campaign for Kuman Selja. She is close to Selja and Randeep Surjevala, while it was believed that former Chief Minister Bhupinder Hooda had lobbied for ticket for Dan Singh.

Infighting in BJP to the fore, Arvind Sharma camp blames Rohtak leaders for poll drubbing

BJP leaders have been taking swipes at the Congress over rampant factionalism in the grand old party. However, in the recently concluded Lok Sabha elections, groupism and infighting were witnessed in the BJP as well.

The BJP leaders have raised much hue and cry over some party insiders sabotaging elections. After BJP's Sonepat candidate Mohan Lal Badauli and Gurugram candidate Rao Indejit Singh, the camp of the party's Rohtak candidate Dr Arvind Sharma has also blamed local party leaders for the poor poll performance. While Sharma and Badauli lost the elections, the winning margin of Rao Indejit

reduced considerably. As per BJP sources, Sharma's wife has expressed displeasure at the role played by a former state minister during canvassing on a WhatsApp group of party workers. However, local BJP leaders say that Sharma's own conduct and the lack of performance as MP and not the alleged lack of support from local leaders had led to his defeat in the elections.

Asked about his poor performance in his own Assembly segment Mahendragarh, Rao Dan Singh admitted he lost there due to his shortcomings.

"It is very easy to blame others for the poor election results. However, those blaming others for their defeat should introspect on their own conduct and performance instead of looking for scapegoats," said a local BJP leader. Political analyst Ranbir Kadian says that it is not right to attribute the defeat or low performance of the BJP candidates to groupism

or infighting in the party. "Some BJP leaders may not have put in their best or sincere efforts to ensure the victory of the party candidates. However, this was a tough election for the ruling party due to strong anti-incumbency. Hence, even if all BJP leaders had supported the party candidates, the results would not have been much different," he observes.

Ranjendra Sharma, Head of the Political Science Department at MDU, Rohtak, says that factionalism prevails in all parties to some extent. "It seemed more prevalent in the Congress as its national leadership has weakened in the recent past. On the other hand, it was not so evident in the BJP owing to its strong national leadership," he notes.

Man kills self after WhatsApp chat with Pak phone number

A 35-year-old man allegedly died by suicide in Faridabad district after a WhatsApp chat with a Pakistan phone number during which he was suspected to have been investigated to hang himself, the police said on Saturday.

The incident took place in Nawada village on the intervening night of Friday and Saturday, the police said. They added that the deceased had been identified as Arun.

Meanwhile, the police registered an FIR on the complaint of

Arun's younger brother Anuj. In the FIR, the complainant stated that when Arun's mother went to his room around 4.30 am on Saturday she saw that he was lying dead on the floor with a noose around his neck, a police spokesperson said.

In the complaint, Anuj stated that "when Arun's mobile phone was checked, it was found that he was chatting on WhatsApp with a Pakistan phone number. Arun was being investigated to commit suicide by hanging himself," the official alleged.

Delay in probe doesn't imply unfairness always: High Court

The Punjab and Haryana High Court has made it clear that mere delay in carrying out a probe does not automatically imply unfairness on the investigating agency's part. The Bench ruled that dissatisfaction with the pace of an investigation did not justify the presumption of bias and the party dissatisfied with the delay could file an application before the "illaga magistrate".

Justice Vinod S Bhardwaj ruled that the magistrate was authorised to examine the delay and call for a report from the police station concerned, ensuring in the process that the grievance regarding the pace of investigation was addressed within the statutory framework.

Justice Bhardwaj also brought to fore the misuse of petitions seeking the transfer of investigations by observing that the parties at times filed restructured pleas to circumvent the statutory remedies. The Bench made it clear that the burden of proof, in such mat-

HOUSE TRESPASS

The Bench was hearing a petition seeking directions to the State of Haryana and other respondents to ensure a fair and impartial investigation by an independent agency in a case alleging house trespass and other offences.

The ruling has significant implications on how parties approach delays in investigations. Stressing the importance of adherence to statutory remedies, the judgment discourages the misuse of judicial processes to alter the course of investigations.

Referring to a plethora of rulings, Justice Bhardwaj said the power to be used only in exceptional circumstances and for securing justice for parties. Numerous judgments had consistently held that requests to transfer an investigation should not be allowed to be "used or deployed by any party for steering the investigation to an agency, which is more feasible to the parties seeking any transfer of investigation".

Before parting with the order, Justice Bhardwaj asserted the incident occurred in August 2023. As such, it was deemed appropriate that the investigation be completed promptly, and the investigating agency file the final report without delay.

Held up due to poll code, work on Faridabad projects to be expedited

The work on some major development projects in the city and the district that was stopped or slowed down after the imposition of the model code of conduct for the past two months is likely to be resumed and expedited.

The authorities concerned are likely to be directed to ensure that the delayed projects are completed before the upcoming state Assembly elections so that these do not lead to resentment among residents or have an adverse impact on the elections, say sources in the district administration. They added that the Lok Sabha election results are also likely to force the authorities to speed up the work on the projects as around three months are left for the Assembly elections.

"The Public Works Department (PWD) plans to get the much-awaited bridge over the Yamuna to connect Faridabad to Greater Noida in Uttar Pradesh formally inaugurated before the Assembly

elections," says Pradeep Sindhu, Executive Engineer, PWD. He adds that though the bridge over the Yamuna near Manjhawali village in the district has been completed, the work on approach roads from both sides is yet to be completed. While the road from the Faridabad side is in the finishing stage, the Uttar Pradesh authorities are being approached to complete the work on their side.

The Rs 300-crore bridge project, the foundation stone of which was laid in August 2014, is expected to reduce

the travelling time between Faridabad and Greater Noida to 30 minutes from 1.30 hours at present. The second major project that is likely to be pushed is the intercity connectivity passage between the NIT and Greater Faridabad, the DPR of which is awaiting approval, according to sources in the Faridabad Metropolitan Development Authority (FMDA), which had taken up the work in 2022. Though Rs 1 crore has been spent on the preparation of a feasibility plan, the project is still on paper.
