The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor (Patron MDUSC) also congratulated Director Sports, all the members of MDU Sports Council, staff of Sports Office, Coaches and Managers and student players on achieving 41 positions during the session 2021-22 by the University sports players in various North-Zone, Inter-University, National and Inter-National competitions etc. The Vice-Chancellor further pointed out that it was not possible to attain such big achievement without their co-operation and hard work in the field of sports. The Patron MDUSC was hopeful that such a pace shall be kept continued in future also. The Worthy Vice-Chancellor also focused on the facilities of the playfield which are maintained at University campus or in pipe line.



Before take up the agenda items for discussion, the Patron MDUSC/ Vice-Chancellor has ordered that in future the items which are to be included in the agenda must be put up before him for prior approval. Thereafter the agenda items were taken for discussion.

RESOLVED THAT THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING OF MDU SPORTS COUNCIL BE CONFIRMED.

2. CONSIDERED THE FOLLOW UP ACTION TAKEN ON THE DECISIONS OF PREVIOUS MEETING (ANNEXURE ALREADY CIRCULATED).

RESOLVED THAT THE FOLLOW UP ACTION BE NOTED AND APPROVED EXCEPT RESO. NO. 9 (I)

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COMMITTEE BE CONSTITUTED BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR TO GO THROUGH THE VARIOUS ASPECTS/CRITERIA RELATED TO GRADATION CERTIFICATE FOR ADMISSION IN COLLEGES/INSTITUTE IN VARIOUS COURSES AGAINST SPORTS QUOTA SEATS AND THE RECOMMENDATIONS/REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE BE PUT UP BEFORE THE VICE-CHANCELLOR FOR CONSIDERATION.

3. CONSIDERED THE BUDGET ESTIMATES OF RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURE OF SPORTS OFFICE FOR THE SESSION 2022-23.

THE BUDGET ESTIMATES OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURE WAS DELIBERATED AT LENGTH AND RESOLVED TO APPROVE AS UNDER:-

- i). THAT THE BUDGET ESTIMATES OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURE AS RECOMMENDED BY THE SPORTS EXECUTIVE BOARD OF ITS MEETING HELD ON 28.09.2022 VIDE ITS RESO. NO. 3 BE APPROVED.
- ii). ALL THE SPORTS ACTIVITIES AS SCHEDULED IN THE SPORTS CALENDAR OF AIU NEW DELHI AND THE INTER-UNIVERSITY GAMES 2022-23 SHALL BE HELD AS USUAL.
- iii). A COMMITTEE BE GOT CONSTITUTED BY THE PATRON MDUSC/VICE-CHANCELLOR TO GO THROUGH THE NECESSARY FACILITIES BEING PROVIDED TO THE STUDENT PLAYERS FOR PARTICIPATION IN VARIOUS GAMES/TOURNAMENTS INCLUDING THE PRIZE MONEY ALONGWITH OTHER FACILITIES TO THE STUDENT PLAYERS, COACHES & MANAGERS. THE RECOMMENDATIONS/REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE BE SUBMITTED TO THE WORTHY VICE-CHANCELLOR AT THE EARLIEST OR LATEST BY END OF NOVEMBER 2022 FOR FURTHER CONSIDERATION.

 - vi). IT WAS ALSO NOTED THAT THE INCOME OF SPORTS OFFICE HAS BEEN DECREASED DUE TO SHIFTING OF THE COLLEGES/INSTITUTES WITH OTHER UNIVERSITY OF STATE. ALL THE MEMBERS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED THAT NEW RESOURCES OF INCOME BE EXPLORED WITH THE BEST UTILIZATION OF THE AVAILABLE INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES AT UNIVERSITY CAMPUS. THE ABOVE COMMITTEE MAY ALSO RE-VISIT THE EXISTING CHARGES OF VARIOUS SPORTS FACILITIES AND GIVE ITS RECOMMENDATIONS. THE COMMITTEE ^{shall} ALSO LOOK IN TO THE POSSIBILITIES OF MORE RESOURCE GENERATION FOR THE SPORTS ACTIVITIES AND SPORTS PROMOTION (ANNEXURE – ALREADY CIRCULATED)

NO. 1, 2 & 7 OF ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE DULY APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE SESSION 2022-23 THROUGH E-TENDERING TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE CPC IN ITS ENSUING MEETING. (ANNEXURE ALREADY CIRCULATED).

CONSIDERED AND APPROVED IN PRINCIPLE FOR PROVIDING THE UNIVERSITY ACCOMMODATION IN VARIOUS UNIVERSITY HOSTELS (BOYS & GIRLS), TRANSIT HOSTELS AND SPORTS HOSTELS FREE OF CHARGES ON PRIORITY AND AS PER AVAILABILITY DURING THE SPORTS ACTIVITIES OF THE SPORTS OFFICE TO BE SCHEDULED AT UNIVERSITY CAMPUS FOR THE USE OF OUTSIDE

PARTICIPATING TEAMS/STUDENT PLAYERS (BOYS & GIRLS), AGAINST PRIOR REQUISITION FOR THE SESSION 2022-23.

THE CHIEF WARDEN (GIRLS) AGREED IN PRINCIPLE DURING THE COURSE OF MEETING TO ARRANGE TO PROVIDE THE FACILITIES OF A WORKING GIRLS HOSTEL EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE PARTICIPATING TEAM GIRLS ALONGWITH THEIR COACHES AND MANAGERS (FEMALE) DURING VARIOUS SPORTS ACTIVITIES/GAMES/TOURNAMENTS HELD AT UNIVERSITY CAMPUS AGAINST PRIOR REQUISITION.

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE FACILITIES OF FACULTY HOUSE OF THE UNIVERSITY SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE AS PER REQUISITION/NEED FROM THE SIDE OF DIRECTORATE OF SPORTS FOR THE STAY OF TECHNICAL EXPERTS, AIU OBSERVERS AND OTHER OFFICIALS TO BE INVITED DURING THE INTER-COLLEGE TOURNAMENTS AND INTER-UNIVERSITY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2022-23 ON OFFICIAL PAYMENT BASIS.

ALSO FURTHER RESOLVED:-

- (i) THAT A GIRLS SPORTS HOSTEL BE CONSTRUCTED AT UNIVERSITY CAMPUS AS PER AVAILABILITY OF SUITABLE SPACE AT UNIVERSITY CAMPUS HAVING CAPACITY OF 150 STUDENT PLAYERS (FEMALE) ALONGWITH THEIR COACHES AND MANAGER FOR THEIR COMFORTABLE STAY DURING THE INTER-COLLEGE TOURNAMENTS/COACHING CAMPS/INTER-UNIVERSITY CHAMPIONSHIPS OF AIU HELD AT MDU CAMPUS AS PER SPORTS CALENDAR. THE POSSIBILITIES OF GETTING FUNDS FROM RELEVANT CENTRAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES BE EXPLORED.
 - (ii) IT WAS ALSO AGREED IN PRINCIPLE THAT THE EXTENSION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TWO UPPER STORIES OVER THE SINGLE FLOOR BUILDING OF EXISTING SPORTS HOSTEL AT UNIVERSITY CAMPUS BE RECOMMENDED. FOR THIS ALSO POSSIBILITIES OF GETTING FUNDS FROM RELEVANT CENTRAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES BE EXPLORED. DIRECTOR SPORTS WILL SUBMIT THE DETAILED PROPOSAL REGARDING (i) & (ii) ABOVE WITH REQUIRMENT AND JUSTIFICATIONS FOR THE SAME WITHIN A MONTH PERIOD TO THE REGISTRAR FOR FURTHER NEEDFUL ACTION.
8. CONSIDERED AND APPROVED THE ENHANCEMENT THE DA AMOUNT OF THE STUDENT PLAYERS DURING COACHING CAMP AND PARTICIPATION IN NORTH



ZONE/ALL INDIA INTER UNIVERSITY FROM THE SESSION 2022-23 IN VIEW OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE SPORTS EXECUTIVE BOARD IN ITS MEETING HELD ON 13.04.2022 VIDE RESO. NO. 8 (i) AS UNDER:-

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT AFTER REVISION OF ABOVE APPROVED FEE EFFECTIVE FROM 2023-24, ROUND OFF 10% INCREASE IN THE SAID FEE FROM THE START OF EVERY ACADEMIC SESSION ONWARDS AFTER 2023-24 WILL ALSO BE APPLICABLE ON THE SAID SPORTS REGISTRATRIION FEE BY ROUNDING OFF THE SAME TO THE NEXT MULTIPLE OF 10. THE SPORTS REGISTRATION FEE WILL BE REMITTED AT THE TIME OF SUBMISSION OF REGISTRATION RETURN (RR).


12. ANY OTHER ITEM(S) WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR.
