At the outset, the Secretary welcomed the President and all the present members of the board and also give the information regarding tremendous position achieved by the MDU Students players in various All India Inter University Championship till date for the session 2021-22 thereafter, the agenda items were taken up for discussion.

1. Considered the minutes of the last meeting of the MDU Sports Executive Board held on 22/11/2021 at 11:30 AM (Annexure – I already circulated)

RESOLVED that the minutes of the last meeting of Sports Executive Board be confirmed.

 Considered the follow up actions taken on the minutes/decisions of the Sports Executive Board in its meeting held on 22/11/2021 at 11:30 AM (Annexure – II already circulated).

Further while considering the follow up action on the Reso. No. 8 of meeting of Sports Executive Board meeting it was unanimously decided that the mater for printing of Annual Program and Annual Reports of previous sessions be taken on war footing for wide circulation.

RESOLVED that the follow up actions be noted and approved.

3. Considered the participation of University players in 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition of Khelo India University Games (KIUG) – 2021 (22) of 20 disciplines approved by SAI at Jain University Bangalore (Karnataka) from 24/04/2022 to 03/05/2022 onwards and also decide the mode of journey (to & fro) alongwith budgetary provision to meet out the expenditure out of MDUSC fund 2021-22 during participation of selected athletes (qualifying teams) and nominated officials as per AIU letter No.AIU/YA&S/KIUG/2022 dated 25/03/2022. (Annexure – III already circulated)



The matter has been discussed in threadbare by the members of the Board and recommended as under for approval of the Patron MDUSC/Vice-Chancellor:-

- a. The contingent of selected athletes (Boys & Girls) and nominated officials (approx 225) be allowed to participate in KIUG 2022 as the MDU teams qualified in 18 streams out of 20 streams approved by SAI and the contingent be allowed preferably by railway tickets (to and fro), in case the railway tickets are not available then the contingent be allowed to travel by air (to and fro) without DA during Journey days.
  - b. The travelling expenditure of the selected athletes and nominated officials be met out of MDUSC Funds with the stipulations that the 50% of the actual expenditure against TA of the selected athletes be recovered from the concerned colleges! institute after participation for which the Sports Office may approach/ request to the concerned college/ institute.
  - c. An amount Rs. 25 Lakh be sanctioned and allowed to drawn as temporary advance out of MDUSC funds 2021-22 for the purpose in favour of Secy. MDUSC and the amount be drawn in 3 / 4 piece meals as per requirement.
- 4. Considered and approved the action taken by the President Sports Executive Board in anticipation of the approval of the Sports Executive Board in allowing re-appropriation of funds from one sub-head to other sub-head of MDUSC Funds as per requirement keeping in view of the urgency in the matter. (Annexure - IV already circulated)
- 5. Considered and Resolved to approve that the date for holding the Annual Sports Prize distribution function for the sessions 2018-19 & 2019-20 be fixed after the approval of the Patron MDUSC/Vice-Chancellor. As far as the budgetary provision for award of cash prize is concerned, the Secy. MDUSC apprised the house during the course of meeting that 50% of total the amount to be disbursed to the position holders as per MDUSC rules will be sponsored by the Managing Director, Sh. Rajesh Jain, LPS Bossard, Rohtak for which he has given the consent and rest of the 50% will be paid from the University main budget after approval of the university competent authority.
