## NORMS FOR RESEARCH PAPER

- The paper should be based on original sources with new interpretations and depth analysis.
- The author/s should mention the title of research paper along with the name/s, designation with Institute, postal & e-mail address and mobile number.
- Research paper should be submitted in MS-Word format (doc/docx and pdf file). Hard copy should be submitted at Conference.
- The abstract should not exceed more than 200 words, along with 7-10 keywords.
- The paper's length should be between 4000-5000 words, excluding notes and references.
- For English- Times New Roman font with a paper title size of 16, subtitle 12 in bold, and main content of 12.
- For Hindi - Kruti Dev 10 font style with a paper title size of 20, subtitle 16 in bold, and main content of 16.
- The line spacing should be kept at 1.5.
- Citations for all the references should be provided in the research paper in Chicago Manual Citation Style 16<sup>th</sup> Edition (For more details, visit <https://haryanahistorycongress.com>)
- Notes and References should be consecutively numbered and presented at the end of the paper.
- The papers should be sent only on this email: [hcresearchpaper@gmail.com](mailto:hcresearchpaper@gmail.com)
- Participants should be submitting their abstract by 31 October, 2025
- The papers which are not found satisfactory by the Expert Committee will not be entertained for presentation.
- Only delegates (life or annual) of the Haryana History Congress can present their research paper in the conference.

Maharshi Dayanand University (MDU), Rohtak, is well connected by road and rail. From Delhi (about 70 km), you can take a direct train or bus to Rohtak. Frequent Haryana Roadways buses and private cabs are available from Delhi ISBTs. Rohtak Railway Station is just 4 km from MDU campus, with auto-rickshaws and e-rickshaws easily available. The nearest airport is Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi (about 75 km). From the airport, one can hire a cab or travel by metro to Delhi ISBT, then proceed to Rohtak by bus or train. The university is located on Delhi Road, Rohtak.
