ENTITLED TO PAYOUT IF DENIED BOARDING? KNOW YOUR RIGHTS AS A DOMESTIC FLYER

The aviation regulator has imposed a penalty of Rs 10 lakh on Akasa Air for failing to compensate 7 passengers denied boarding on a Sept 6 Bengaluru-Pune flight. **TOI** looks at compensation norms for being denied boarding

SEPT INCIDENT
The aircraft scheduled for the route was grounded and the replacement aircraft had nine non-operational seats. So Akasa transferred 7 passengers to an Indigo flight that departed nearly two hours later. The question is: how does flight time difference between original and alternative flights decide quantum of compensation?

THE RULES

- Airlines can legally deny boarding. To reduce the possibility of flight departing with empty seats (some passengers don't show up) airlines can overbook flights to a limited extent.
- When more passengers board than the number of available seats, the airline must deny boarding to some.
- If the offloaded passenger is booked on an alternative flight that departs within an hour of the original flight's scheduled departure, the airline need not pay compensation.
- Else, the airline must pay compensation that is equal to 200% of the booked one-way basic fare plus airline fuel charge, or Rs 10,000, whichever is lower.

FOR MUCH DELAYED DEPARTURE

- If a passenger does not opt for alternate flight, full ticket refund and compensation equal to 400% of booked one-way basic fare plus airline fuel charge or ₹20,000, whichever lower, should be compensation if the alternative flight departs more than 24 hours after the original flight's time.

Forces flush out gunmen, destroy bunkers in Manipur

Guwahati: Security forces in Manipur destroyed four bunkers and occupied three others belonging to gunmen during a combined search by Army, Border Security Force (BSF), Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), and police since Saturday in Imphal East and Kangpokpi districts, officials said Monday. The operation was initiated after four people, including a policeman and a woman, were wounded in gun attacks in two villages Friday. Armed gunmen from adjoining hills in Kangpokpi attacked low-lying Thamnappi and Sanasabi villages, resulting in an exchange of fire with security forces and village volunteers. Violence erupted in the strife-torn state since Tuesday after a brief lull, disrupting Christmas. "During the operation, all armed miscreants from these areas have been flushed out," police said. Security searches resulted in the confiscation of arms, ammunition, and explosives over the past week, especially in Churachandpur and Tengnoupal. Police said two active members of banned militant outfit PREPAK were arrested in Imphal West. They were allegedly involved in extortion. Three mobile phones, 12 extortion letters, and a four-wheeler were seized from them.

Docs move HC to pause transfer of Bhopal gas tragedy waste

Indore: While MP govt prepares on a war footing to transfer Union Carbide waste from Bhopal to a disposal facility in Dhar's Pithampur, a petition was filed before the Indore bench of the state HC Monday, seeking to halt the transportation, reports **Salil Mekaad**. The petitioners seek formation of a judicial committee to check impact of disposal on people who live in the vicinity of the waste disposal plant. They fear disposal of the waste will have a "grave impact" on Pithampur and Indore. In the past few days, govt has repeatedly assured safety concerns. Gas tragedy relief department director Swatantra Kumar Singh Sunday held a press meet where he said incineration of the toxic waste will not have any adverse impact on land and soil of villages. Still, landfill has been created so that the waste doesn't come into contact with water or soil during incineration, he assured, pointing out that disposal of 10 tonne waste has already been carried out at the best of HC and no harmful effect was found in the area.

LPG tanker tragedy: Auto owner who helped save lives fights for survival

Jaipur: Shatrughan Shah, 40, vegetable vendor, is running from pillar to post for help after losing his auto rickshaw in the devastating inferno triggered by a collision between an LPG tanker and a truck near Bhankrota on Jaipur-Ajmer highway on Dec 20. Despite suffering burn injuries to his face, Shah's name does not appear on the list of injured, leaving him without any compensation. Speaking to **TOI** Monday, Shah recounted the terrifying sequence of events leading to the accident. He was on the highway when he found himself amid the disaster. "I was transporting vegetables when I saw gas leaking from the LPG tanker. The entire area was soon enveloped in a thick fog of gas. Then, an unknown ignition sparked a fire," Shah said. He described how, in a panic, he tried to flee but his muffer and shawl caught fire. "I threw away my muffer and shawl but my face still got partially burnt," he added. As he ran towards a nearby school, he witnessed people engulfed in flames and crying for help. Shah, along with others, quickly took action, rushing the injured to the hospital in whatever vehicles they could find. "It was chaotic but I couldn't just stand there. I had to help," Shah said. Shah's troubles did not end with the fire. When he later checked on his auto rickshaw, he discovered it was damaged when a truck collided with it while attempting to reverse. "I lost my vehicle and now I'm left with nothing," Shah said. To make matters worse, his name was not included in state govt's list of injured since he was not admitted to SMS hospital, leaving him without access to compensation. "I earned my living by selling vegetables. Now I don't know how to survive," he said. ADM North Mukesh Kumar said Shah has submitted an application, which will be processed soon. For now, Shah continues to wait, hoping that authorities will not forget him in his time of need.
