Guidance, Counseling and Coaching Programme for Civil Services Examination 2026

UCCE organised coaching classes for written examinations for IAS and Allied Services in the past in accordance with the original mandate of the UGC for this centre. This programme was expanded to include HCS and Allied Services and later on for many other written Examinations conducted by UPSC, HPSC, UGC and Banking Services Recruitment bodies. All these coaching programmes are being organised but the coaching programme for IAS and Allied Services/HCS and Allied Services could not be organized after 2014/2018 for various reasons. However, in view of the rising number of aspirants of our region these days, the programme with a multipronged and layered approach is being rolled out w.e.f. November 2025. The programme is open to all candidates but the focus is on CSE aspirants of Haryana. Salient features of the programme are:

- Area specific classes will be conducted by Experts
- Easy access to the vast reading material (both print and e-books)
- Dedicated well furnished high speed wi fi enabled space in the Vivekananda Library of MDU
- Special Hostel accommodation for both men and women aspirants
- Dedicated classes for up scaling of writing skills
- Availability of Advisor(s) in the Library on all working days
- Special library membership to all candidates enrolled in the coaching programme
- Differently able persons friendly buildings
- Facilities for sign language expert and reading material in audio format, if required
- **Free counselling and guidance sessions from 10 to 15 November 2025 in UCCE, (Swaraj Sadan) MDU between 11: 00 AM AND 4:00 PM**
- Registration at a nominal fee of Rs. 5000/- for assessment classes will be made from 10 to 16 November 2025 and the classes will be held from 17 to 30 November 2025. This schedule ends with a 03 hrs 30 minutes test on 28 November 2025 to be followed by discussion and feedback on the test and assessment classes on 29 and 30 November 2025. The test will of both types: MCQ and descriptive.

Guidance, Counselling and Coaching for Civil Services Examinations
w.e.f. Session 2025-26

UCCE organised coaching classes for written examinations for IAS and Allied Services in the past in accordance with the original mandate of the UGC for this centre. This programme was expanded to include HCS and Allied Services and later on for many other written Examinations conducted by UPSC, HPSC, UGC and Banking Services Recruitment bodies. All these coaching programmes are being organised but the coaching programme for IAS/HCS and Allied Services could not continue for various reasons. However, in view of the rising number of aspirants of our region these days, the programme needs to be rolled out again. This programme may be initiated with a multipronged and layered approach. A workable trajectory is given below.

1. Encourage and motivate:

- (a) Interactions with young IAS and Allied Services officers
- (b) Interactions with serving and retired civil servants for extended interactions, guidance and counselling.

2. Enrolment of the Aspirants in the Batch:

- All interested aspirants will be registered for an initial period of 14 days as day scholars at a nominal fee of Rs. 5000/-. During this period (17 to 30 November 2025) classes will be held and continuous evaluation will also be done to ascertain the readiness of the candidates to take CSE seriously. At the end of this period a comprehensive screening test will be held to form the batch. This schedule ends with a 03 hrs 30 minutes test on 28 November 2025 to be followed by discussion and feedback on the test and classes. The test will of both types: MCQ and descriptive.

3. Library support:

- (a) A ready list of relevant reading material with location of each source in the library for both in print and the digital forms.
- (b) A dedicated monitored entree hall with workstations and high speed wi-fi.
- (c) Issue of 4 Books for a week only for hall and two books for taking out of library for two weeks.

4. Resident Advisors/Counsellors:

At least one advisor/counsellor will be available in the designated room on all working days for 2-4 hours to address general problems of the CSE aspirants and other topic/area specific advisors will be available on appointment basis.

Fortnightly tests on specific topics for Paper I and II of Preliminary and GS I to IV will be conducted for continuous evaluation and feedback.

5. Essay and Qualifying Papers of English and Hindi:

- (a) Short term remedial classes for the qualifying Language Papers for the candidates who may require will be organised in the initial phase of the coaching programme so that they may not interfere with the concerted effort of the candidates in the run up to the main examinations.
- (b) Most candidates may need a sprucing up of their writing skills as they are required not only to write two long essays (100-1200 words each) in the Essay Paper but they also need to write many answers (may be loosely termed short essays) ranging from 100 words to 300 words in the GS Papers. The skills of composing essays will add to their abilities to communicate ideas more convincingly in a coherent manner in GS Papers. The candidates will also be benefitted in a similar manner when it comes to write their answers in their Optional Subject Papers.

- 6. Since the temporal window between the Preliminary and the Main Examinations is quite narrow and does not allow a significant intervention in the final stage of preparation (barely 8-10 weeks) for the Mains, the coaching programme has been designed to take care of all the three stages – Prelims, Mains and the Interview.

- 7. **The main coaching programme for the batch will start from 03 December 2025 to the first week of August with suspension of classes for 10-14 days for CSE (P) 2026.**

- 8. **Fee for the coaching programme: Rs. 80,000/-**

- 9. **Hostel Charges: as applicable for different hostel facilities.**
