Mega tree plantation drive on 09-08-2024 in premises of Sardar Vallabhbhai 1. Patel Cricket Stadium, M.D. University

and response protocols in cardiac emergencies.



11. Five Day Health Awareness Camp for YRC Counselors and Volunteers of local colleges and U.T.D. from 18.02.2025 to 22.02.2025



14. Two Day Training Program on Addiction Case Management from 24.02.2025 to 25.02.2025




identifying and addressing community challenges. Dr. Karmvir Sheokand, Deputy Director, University Outreach Programme, extended a formal vote of thanks.

commitment to promoting regional arts and heritage.








19. Anaemia Mukt, Poshan Yukt Campaign in Maharshi Dayanand University on 07.04.2025 to 08.04.2025


















25. Celebration of International Yoga Day on 21.06.2025

Department, University Outreach Program and Youth Red Cross.






26. One day training program on "Basic First Aid and Disaster Management" on 14.07.2025




The campaign encouraged active participation from all sections of society, exemplifying the power of collective action in advancing both environmental and social causes.
