Copy of extract of Reso. No. 17 of the meeting of the Executive Council held on 29/09/2025

17. Consideration of the proposal regarding amendment in the Chapter – 25 (Participation in Seminars/Conferences/Workshops etc. by teachers of University teaching Department / Maintained Colleges) of the University Calendar Vol.III, in view of the recommendations of the committee, constituted by the Vice-Chancellor, made in its meeting held on 21.03.2025 against Sr. No. 3 (Annexure A/144 pages 901-903, already circulated) and in light of various E.C. Resolutions No. 17 dated 12.06.2014, Reso. No.122 dated 29.06.2016, Reso. No. 4 dated 04.09.2019, Reso. No. 50 dated 29.07.2020 & Reso. No. 10 dated 04.06.2021 as under:

i) For attending International Seminars and Conferences Abroad.	No Change
Besides the UGC grant, University should contribute at least an amount of Rs. 20 Lacs/ annum for meeting out the expenses for attending the International Conferences / Seminar abroad.	No Change
Further, a teacher is entitled 100% grant for International Conferences / Seminar etc. abroad (after three years) maximum ceiling of Rs. 1.25 Lacs shall be restricted for Regn. Fee, Visa Fee, Air Fare, TA/DA, Accommodation etc. etc.	No Change
For faculty seeking travel grant for attending international conferences outside India, the grant may be made admissible only for the faculty who have published two publications in SCOPUS/Web of Science in the year	For faculty seeking travel grant for attending international conferences outside India, the grant may be made admissible only for the faculty who has two publications in SCOPUS/Web of Science or one granted patent or

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prior to travel date or give her/his consent to publish one publication within one year after his/her return, failing which she/he may be asked to refund the amount.

consultancy project of minimum **5.0 lakh** (completed or ongoing), or research project of minimum 5.0 lakh (completed or ongoing) in the last two years prior to the travel date OR give her/his undertaking to publish two publications in SCOPUS/Web of Science or fetch consultancy project of minimum **5.0 lakh** OR research project of minimum 5.0 lakh within two years after his/her return, failing which she/he may be asked to refund the amount. For subjects where SCOPUS/ WoS listed journals are not available/ lesser in number, in that case **the publications in Peer Reviewed and Referred Journal (after 10.02.2025) will be considered.** In the case of non-science subjects, the faculty member may be allowed on the basis of one book publication or two chapters in two different books published by international publisher in the year prior to travel date OR give her/his consent to publish. However, in exceptional circumstances Vice-Chancellor may relax the above mentioned conditions based on outstanding work by the faculty member, in case the above conditions are not met.

The payment of daily allowance will be made at Govt. of Haryana rates and D.A. will be paid for the duration of the conferences plus four days i.e. two days before and two days after the conference which will include the travel period. If the journey period is less than two days before and two days after then actual DA will be given for the actual journey days, which shall be maximum two days.

Persons selected for participation should travel by excursion tickets in sectors by the cheapest air ticket by any air line (in any case not exceeding Air India Fare). Actual fare not exceeding A.C. Class-II Fare will be admissible for travel from University/College Head Quarter to

the nearest Airport and back.

However, taxi fare for travel upto the airport from the Head Quarter may be allowed by the Vice-Chancellor on the basis of entitlement.

Two teachers or 20% of the total strength of the departments, whichever is more, in a Department be allowed to proceed for participation in the same Conference, Seminar, Workshop etc. in abroad at a given time. However, in case of UIET not more than two teachers from a branch/stream be allowed at a given time for the said purpose.

Travel grant upto 100% by entitled class and delegation fee and D.A. be given to a teacher. If a teacher is eligible to travel by air he may be allowed to travel by air in economy class and his travel expenses may be reimbursed on the basis of actual expenses incurred or Rs. 10,000/- whichever is lower.

Travel grant upto 100% by entitled class and delegation fee and D.A. be given to a teacher. If a teacher is eligible to travel by air she/ he may be allowed to travel by air in economy class and the travel expenses may be reimbursed on the basis of actual expenses incurred or Rs. 20,000/- whichever is lower.

The teachers be allowed to participate in Seminars/ Conferences/ Workshops within India once for National and once for International Conference, OR two International Conferences with financial assistance in a financial year subject to availability of funds.

Not more than 25% of the teachers or three teachers whichever is lower of the deptt. may be allowed to attend same National Conferences except if the Conferences is being organized by the concerned subject association.
