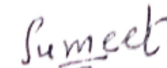
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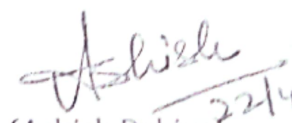

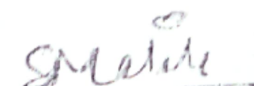

Article 1: OBJECTIVES

Article 2: SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

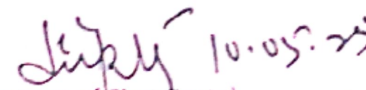
a) Party A (MD UNIVERSITY):

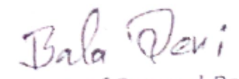
- The University will provide infrastructure and work environment as per University policy.

- Boarding and lodging of Industry experts at university faculty house shall be borne by university.
- The selected startups will be governed by the University Policy.
- Press Releases: All press releases shall be jointly approved by both the Parties in case there is a name/services in use by either of the Parties. The Parties shall examine and explore future possibilities of working together with respect to areas covered under this MOU and take further action as may be mutually decided

b) Party B (Ruhil Future Technologies Private Limited):

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Ruhil Future Technologies Private Limited commits to providing mentorship, ensuring that students benefit from valuable guidance throughout their entrepreneurial journey.
- In addition to mentorship, Ruhil Future Technologies Private Limited pledges to offer practical guidance, assisting students in navigating challenges and making informed decisions for their startup ventures.
- Leveraging its industry expertise, Ruhil Future Technologies Private Limited will share valuable insights with students, helping them gain a competitive edge and thrive in their respective sectors.
- Facilitate networking opportunities and connect students with relevant resources.
- Contribute to the success of the incubation centre through knowledge sharing and collaboration.
- Shall provide support for the selection of startups for the MDU.
- Shall assist in the provision of common services such as product development and technology audit.
- Will provide a training and development program for employees of the incubation centre at MDU.
- Shall provide support for outreach, investor connect, and event management.
- Will provide a pool of mentors, speakers, and entrepreneurs to MDU for conducting events, workshops, and mentoring sessions. The travel and all other expenses (other than boarding and lodging at faculty house) of resource persons will be borne by Ruhil

Future Technologies Private Limited. The process flow, domain areas and list of activities and training programs to be conducted are attached as Annexure-I.

Article 3: Entry into Effect, Modification, and Termination

- (i) This MoU becomes effective upon signing and is valid for Two years with provision of renewal on the recommendations of JCC on mutually agreed terms and condition. Termination is possible after one year by agreement of both parties.
- (ii) Joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of this MoU may continue under its terms.
- (iii) Amendments: Any amendments or modifications to this MoU must be made in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both Parties. Changes will become effective as specified.

Article 4: Settlement of Dispute

The parties could act strictly according to the provisions of Law while implementing this MoU. In case, In case of any dispute between the contracting parties, it would firstly be amicably settled by mutual discussions. In case of any dispute remaining unresolved it would be referred to the sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Vice Chancellor of Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak with the mutual consent of both the parties. The venue of the Arbitration proceeding shall be at Rohtak only and language of Arbitration shall be in English. The Arbitration proceeding shall be conducted in terms of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification of re-enactment thereof and the expenses of the Arbitration proceeding shall be borne equally by the Parties or as may be decided by the Arbitrator.

The legal jurisdiction shall be Rohtak courts only.

Article 5: Force Majeure

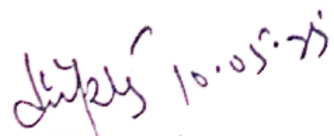
Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligation under this MoU due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events, such as, but not limited to Acts of God, War, Flood, Earthquakes, Strike(s), Lockout(s), Epidemics, Riots, Civil commotion etc provided on occurrence and cessation of such events, the party affected by these shall give a notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence and cessation. If the majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

Article 6: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Intellectual property developed during the incubation period shall be owned as per the policy of the University.

Article 7: CONFIDENTIALITY

Both Parties (A&B) agree to maintain the confidentiality of sensitive information shared during the collaboration.
