Vide reference cited above, the 34th Annual General Meeting of the Inter University Sports Board, 2025 resolved that the AIU Sports Logo shall be incorporated and printed on all sports kits (Jersey, Travel T-shirt, Tracksuit, etc.) of athletes and officials participating in Inter University Competitions.

Subject: Revision of University Team Registration Fee for Participation in Inter-University Events (2025–26 Onwards)

The Inter-University Sports Board of AIU in its 34th Annual General meeting held on 6th August 2025 at Sharda University resolved to revise the **Team Registration Fee for participation in Inter-University Events** w.e.f. 2025-26 as under:


Existing Team Registration Fee (Per Team / Per Event)	Revised Team Registration Fee (Per Team / Per Event)
Rs. 3000.00 (including GST)	Rs. 5000.00 (including GST)

The corpus generated through the enhanced fee shall be utilized exclusively for the development and promotion of sports, with a special focus on:

- Establishment and strengthening of AIU Centres of Excellence to nurture emerging talent;
- Provision of financial assistance and support to athletes and officials representing AIU in the FISU World University Games / Championships;
- Support for Combined University Events, Federation Cup etc. and other competitions contributing to the visibility and stature of university sports.
- Cash Award for Athlete of the Year to be introduced w.e.f. 2025-26

The utilization of the corpus, so generated, shall commence from the academic session 2025–26 onwards, and the amount collected shall be applied strictly for sports-related purposes after deducting administrative charges.

All participating and host universities / institutes are requested to take note of the above and ensure strict compliance while registering teams for participation in Inter-University Events from the academic session 2025–26 onwards.

Sub: Enhancement in the Strength of Players in Kabaddi

Ref: Letter received from the Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India dated 06.09.2025

Vide paper read above, the Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India has informed the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) that the strength of players in Kabaddi has been enhanced from 12 (twelve) to 14 (fourteen) to ensure better team rotation, effective injury management, and overall improved performance. The Federation has further requested AIU to implement the same in all AIU competitions with effect from the academic year 2025–26 onwards.

Sanction has been accorded by the Hon'ble Secretary General, AIU, to enhance the strength of players in Kabaddi from 12 to 14 in AIU Inter-University competitions, effective from the academic year 2025–26.
