2027-28 Fulbright-Nehru Fellowships for Indian Citizens

Fulbright-Nehru Doctoral Research Fellowships: These pre-doctoral level research fellowships, for six to nine months, are designed for Indian scholars who are registered for a Ph.D. at an Indian institution.

Application Deadline: July 1, 2026.

Fulbright-Nehru Postdoctoral Research Fellowships: These fellowships, for eight to 24 months, are designed for Indian faculty and researchers who have a Ph.D. or D.M. degree within the past four years.

Application Deadline: July 15, 2026.

Fulbright-Nehru Academic and Professional Excellence Fellowships: These fellowships, for four to nine months, aim to provide Indian faculty, researchers, and professionals with the opportunity to teach, conduct research, or carry out a combination of teaching and research at a U.S. institution.

Application Deadline: July 1, 2026.

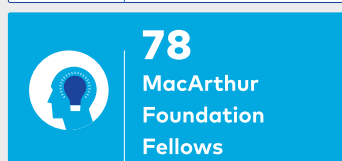
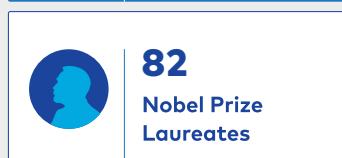
